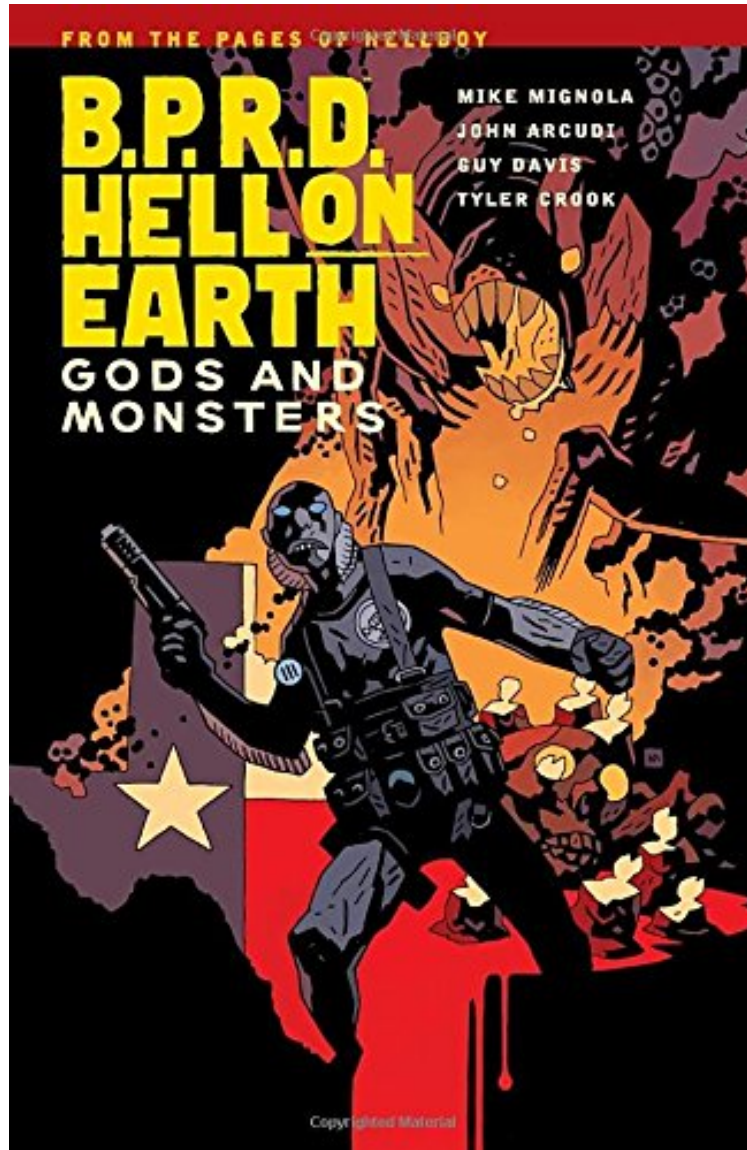

Can a fractured B.P.R.D. wage a winnable war or are they fighting a battle of attrition? Written by Mike Mignola and John Arcudi, and drawn by 2009 Eisner Award winner Guy Davis (*The Marquis*) and series newcomer Tyler Crook, *B.P.R.D. Hell on Earth: Gods and Monsters* continues the series ComicsAlliance calls "one of the best books on the stands."

About the AuthorMike Mignola was born September 16, 1960 in Berkeley, California and grew up in nearby Oakland. His fascination with ghosts and monsters began at an early age and reading *Dracula* at age 13 introduced him to Victorian literature and folklore from which he has never recovered. In 1993 Mike moved to Dark Horse comics and created *Hellboy*, a half-demon occult detective who may or may not be the Beast of the Apocalypse. While the first story line *Seed of Destruction*, was co-written by John Byrne, Mike has continued writing the series himself. There are, at this moment, numerous *Hellboy* graphic novel collections with more on the way, several spin-off titles (*BPRD*, *Lobster Johnson*, *Abe Sapien* and *Witchfinder*), three anthologies of prose stories, several novels, two animated films, and two live action films starring Ron Perlman, and a new *Hellboy* movie in the works. *Hellboy* has earned numerous comic industry awards and is published in a great many countries.
