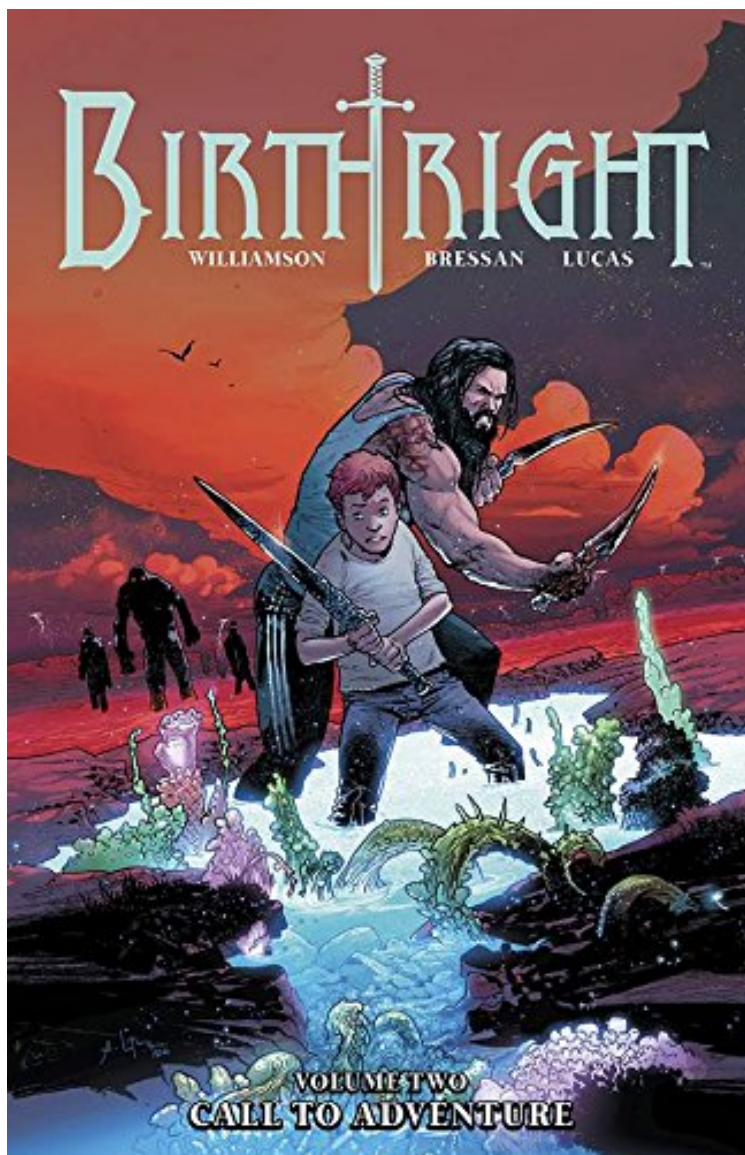

A young boy goes missing in a park on his birthday. His father didn't do it but is blamed anyway. The marriage falls apart and the older son is ignored. One year later, the 30 year old vagabond is arrested in possession of a variety of medieval weapons. The father knows it is his son while the mother think both are

crazy. The younger boy was off in another world fighting monsters and wizards for the last two decades, but the conflict has spilled over to Earth. He talks about being a great hero, when in fact, he is a great betrayer. In this volume, the brothers are on the run from the law and fighting incursions from the other dimension. Other than the villain disguised as a hero, the characters are one dimensional. The dialogue needs some work. The artwork is mixed. If I read this as a kid, I would have loved it.
