more frustrating to read through. My excitement is not all lost but most of it is gone. Image did big disservice to a really good comic book... Very poor build quality By Yggdrasil Yesterday I received my copy of the 2nd printing of Black Science... I could not believe my eyes:- horrible binding: glued binding which is extremely tight so you get a lot of gutter loss (i.e. I could not read what was between the pages). Horrible cracking noise each time you open the book or try to force it to open up a bit more- no head or tail ribbons... I have rarely seen that for a major publisher. Actually I think that's the first time I see that for a collected edition of this size and price.- wavy pages, and the whole page block is curved To add to the injury: Black science first printing had the small issue of lettering on one page (which is why the book was withdrawn and reprinted), but it had sewn binding, head and tail ribbons, no gutter loss... Amazing... Second printing was obviously rushed and Image cut corners on quality. I bought for the same price a book which does not open and has a horrible build quality. for a 50\$ book, it's inexcusable. Buy the trades instead, or try to find the rare first printing, otherwise it is not worth it, Image did a horrible job.
