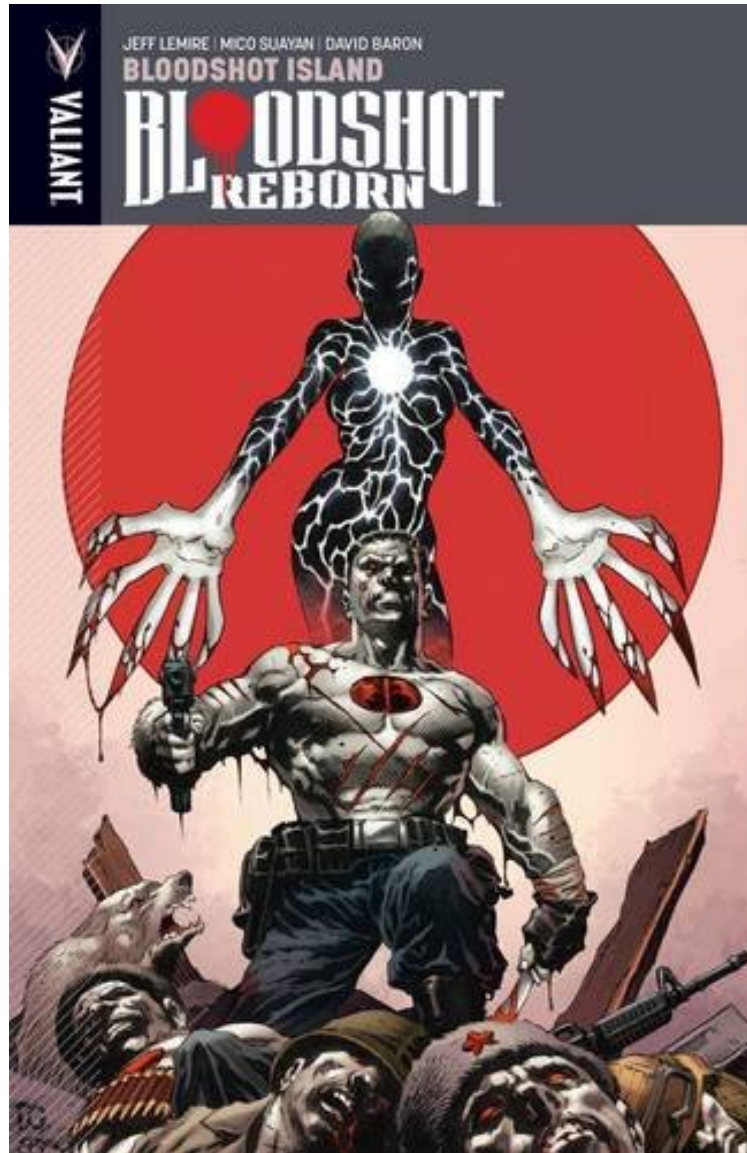

It's the kind of story I tend to hate the most in comics in that it's a heroes being mostly the cause of all the damage thing. Lemire slightly mitigates the damage but it's there and it's annoying to me. Thankfully, it's made up for by being fast moving

and probably way closer to 1980s Commando than he wants it to be. Funnily enough, the best thing about the book might just be the story about the summer camp slasher at the end of the book. Unfortunately, it's also only a few pages. Visually, the book looks fantastic. Mico Suyan, Tomas Giorello, Kano, Benjamin Marra, etc all do good work here. They each bring out different aspects of the character while not losing the basic look and feel. The coloring teams are all top notch and really nail the tone. It's not a bad volume. I just realize that the story ultimately isn't really for me. I tend to prefer my heroes fighting villains instead of personal uncertainty. Lemire thankfully executes it all well enough that it's not a drag and the illustration teams help with the rest.
