If you have never read Bomb Queen, well, I don't really know what to say. On the one hand I'd recommend it if you're an Image comic fan, it really is a great addition to that universe, but on the

other hand it's a bit of an acquired taste. Took me a while to get into the series, gave up on trying to get into the character, and mostly read it as an achievement in "none-development" what do I mean, well, it's a book about a villain, and she stays a villain, seriously, so there's not much you can do with that. Now some may say that that's a negative, and while in storytelling it is a bit of a drag on the reader, I found it to be an interesting read once I stopped trying to care about how "bad" the whole thing was and realized the subtle achievement Jimmie Robinson had made, he'd stuck to his guns on a book about a villain. No becoming heroic later, not transitioning into anti-hero, no learning from your mistakes/moral of the story, none of that, Bomb Queen is evil, and if at first she doesn't succeed in hammering in a nail, she just gets a bigger hammer. If you are not into "adult" comics then you may have a problem with Bomb Queen, but even if you are you may still have a problem with Bomb Queen just for what it is.
