Compared to the lackluster storytelling of volume one (Borderlands Volume 1 Origins), The Fall of Fyrestone tells the story of the original Borderlands protagonists, and their early game dealings with bandits, Scar, and Nine Toes. There's the occasional piece of awkward dialogue shared between the characters, but otherwise their interactions felt smooth and natural.

Said characters (Roland, Lilith, Mordecai, and Brick) are depicted about how you would expect Vault Hunters to be: crass, unprofessional, but overall, very good at killing things. I feel the relationship between Roland and Lilith was depicted the strongest, although I did appreciate the lovably annoying Claptrap as an individual character a little more.
