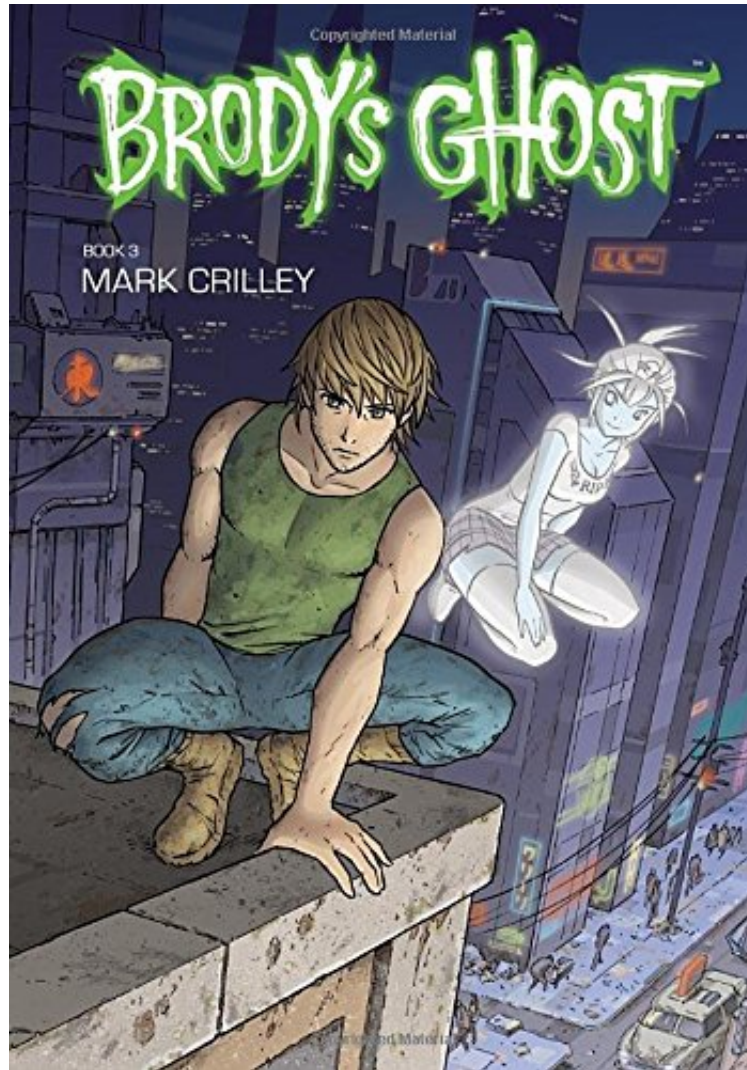

What I have seen though is quite impressive; in a way, he sort of reminds me of the great Patrick "Spaz" Spaziante of Archie Comics Sonic the Hedgehog books, and that, coming from me, is very high praise indeed. When I saw the Brody's Ghost series,I decided I should try it an see his work in action and I will tell you, Mr. Crilley does not disappoint.First, let's talk about the story: picking up where the last book left off, Brody has been following his ex-girlfriend, Nicole,

after seeing an image of her dead body, which, in turn, causes him to believe she's to be the next victim of the dangerous Penny Murder. I won't reveal too much more, but I will say that the story is definitely well-told; it plays out a bit like a murder mystery, with a dose of the paranormal and, more so in the other books, a bit of kung fu action thrown in for spice. Then there's the artwork. Like the aforementioned "Spaz", Crilley does a great job bringing out that "manga feel" in an otherwise American made book. His attention to detail is great and his characters are very expressive and fun to watch. I especially like the scenes where characters go all wide-eyed, because it adds humour to the otherwise gritty atmosphere and keeps it from being \*too\* dark and depressing (like far too much of most entertainment today). All in all, I'm really liking the way the series is shaping up. As of this writing, I already have the first four parts of the series and can't wait for the last two.
