Buffy is plagued by dreams of fellow Slayer Faith, who now lies in a coma. Jane Espenson, the celebrated writer from the Buffy TV show, writes the powerful Faith story Haunted. And as summer comes to an end, Buffy and Willow begin their first year of college in The Blood of Carthage, a story written by acclaimed Buffy novelist Christopher Golden. Meanwhile, Buffy embarks on a new romance with Riley Finn, and Willow and Oz's relationship comes to an end in Golden's Oz: Into the Wild. This volume also features work by Buffy Season 8 contributors Cliff Richards, Paul Lee, and Brian Horton. About the Author Joss Whedon was born in New York City in 1964. He started out as a staff writer for the 1990s sitcom *Roseanne* and worked on films, including *Toy Story*. In 1992 he penned the script for a film, *Buffy the Vampire Slayer*, and when the TV version starring Sarah Michelle Gellar took off in 1997, Whedon had his big break with its female action heroine, Buffy, became a huge hit. Whedon wrote hundreds of episodes for Buffy and its spin-off *Angel*, and was nominated for Emmy and Hugo awards for his work. Whedon has come to enjoy a cult following. The author lives in Santa Monica, California. Cliff Richards is a comic book artist known for Buffy the Vampire Slayer, *Angel* and *Faith*, *Dollhouse*, *Ghost*, *Spike*, and *Wonderwoman*. Richards was born in Brazil. Christopher Golden is the New York Times bestselling author of such novels as *Snowblind*, *Tin Men*, *The Myth Hunters*, *Wildwood Road*, *The Boys Are Back in Town*, *The Ferryman*, *Strangewood*, and *Of Saints and Shadows*. He has also written books for teens and young adults, including *Poison Ink*, *Soulless*, and the thriller series *Body of Evidence*, which was honored by the New York Public Library and chosen as one of YALSA's Best Books for Young Readers. Golden cowrote the illustrated novel *Baltimore*, or, *The Steadfast Tin Soldier and the Vampire* with Mike Mignola, which became the launching pad for the cult favorite comics series *Baltimore*.
