These Captain America solo stories from the Tales of Suspense issues (1964-1966) are written by Stan Lee, and most of them are illustrated by a more mature Jack Kirby. Other guest-star illustrators include John Romita, Dick Ayers, and George Tuska. Most of the stories are contemporary, but Lee takes a few detours into Golden-age material, retelling the story of Cap's origins and the beginning of his crime-fighting career with his sidekick Bucky Barnes against the evil forces of Nazism and the Red Skull. More

contemporary stories (1964-66) bring back the threat of the Red Skull and a new organization, called THEM, that fights against SHIELD. Although these issues are characterized by pure action-packed plots, occasional detours into Cap's personal life build inner conflicts in CA, such as missing Bucky Barnes, and a woman he loved during WWII. Through these stories, Lee shows great dexterity in story-telling rarely seen in comics. And Kirby's artwork (with due respect to the others) is in a mature form.
