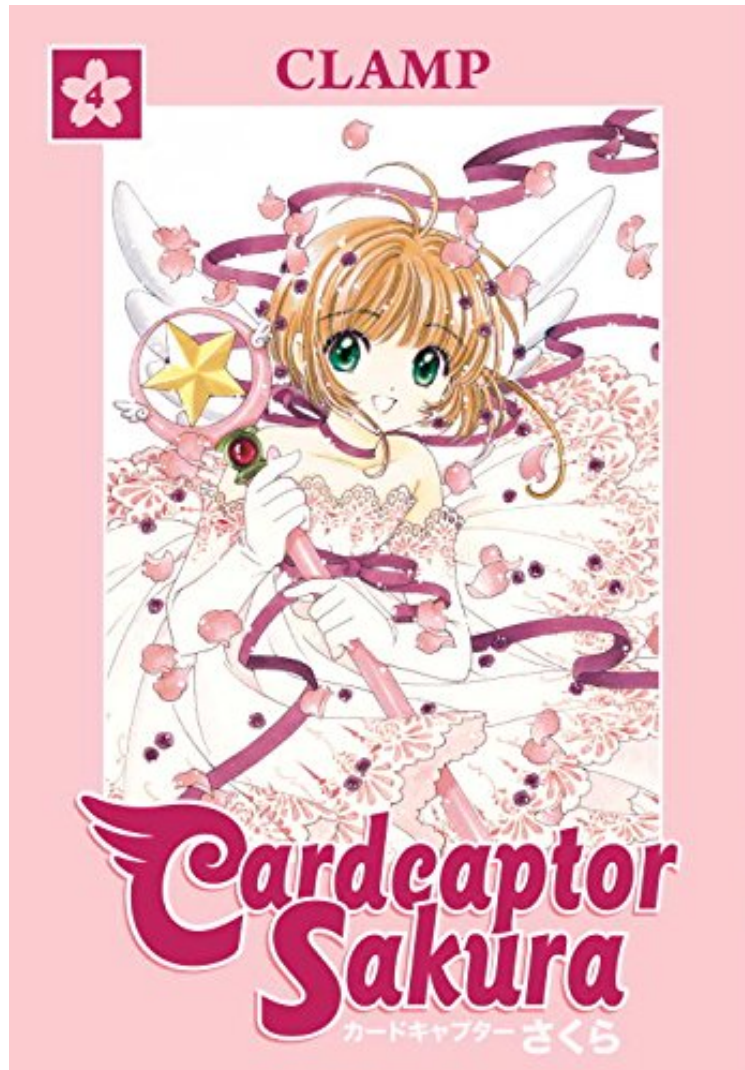

Aside from that the images were nice and sharp. As for the story. This is one of the sweetest stories that I've ever read. Sakura grows so much during the series. So when I saw that the whole series was being offered in omnibus format, in nothing less than my favorite color, I jumped to get these right away. I ordered all 4 at the same time a couple of weeks back, and got them in a timely manner, and I'm very happy with them and the color illustrations. However, I have one small complaint. The spine for my Omnibus #1, #2, and #4 are a certain design, but the spine for #3 is slightly different! This causes an awkward visual when these are put in my bookshelf. After a bit of research, I found out that Dark Horse changed their spine design between the printing of #3 and #4, and that #1 and #2 were updated once their second editions came out. #3, however, has apparently yet to be published with an updated matching spine design, because wherever I look, it has the old version, so I recommend waiting until the 2nd edition of #3 comes out before ordering the entire set, so you can have a nice matching set in your bookshelf :) 4 of 4 people found the following review helpful. beautiful cover and great packaging!
