underrated, and love Ocean's 11. But I also like smart stuff -- I majored in poetry and read philosophy like Slavoj Žižek for fun. And I want heart -- if you don't get choked up at the end of Ratatouille, I can't deal with you. Casanova is my favorite comic book of all time -- even better than things by Miller, Morrison and Moore -- because it does sexy and smart and heart so well. It is a great spy science fiction adventure with cool clothes and sexy characters, and violence and charm, the characters pack an emotional punch dealing with things I won't spoil here, and it is also very smart on intellectual issues like the state of the comics industry and what men should act like. Let me admit that this review is pretty self serving. I love Casanova so much I wrote a whole book about how great it is, and Casanova artist Fabio Moon designed the cover: *The Future of Comics, the Future of Men: Matt Fraction's Casanova*. But I would not have devoted so much time to a comic book if I was not genuinely obsessed with it. It seems to be tongue-in-cheek with lots of sex and violence. The main character gets lost in time for a good part of the story but all the other characters are involved in their own plots in many senses of the word. I found this collection quite hard to read in the digital edition. The writing was quite small as were the illustrations on the whole. There are also an abundance of flashbacks which are not easy to recognise creating confusion in this reader anyway. The artwork was good on the whole and there's a lot of information at the end about how this comic was conceived and drawn.
