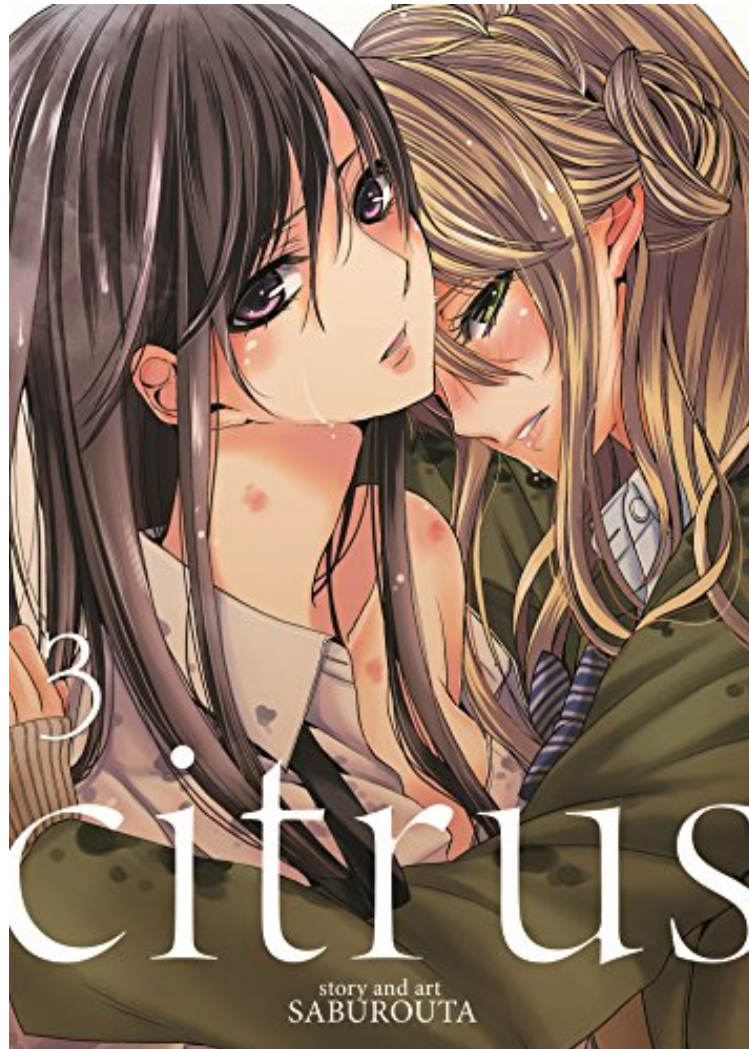

Nonetheless, all of this serves to progress the entertaining love story between Yuzu and Mei. In this book, we get to meet Matsuri! Mischievous and the youngest of the cast, Matsuri is Yuzu's childhood friend. Knowing each other for so long, she was pretty much a little sister to Yuzu.
