This is a volume that has two great stories. The first involves Yuzu and Mei going out on a date. Yuzu has put together a guide for building a relationship with Mei but when Mei finds her notebook, she decides that the two of them will go out using Yuzu's "perfect date" template. It makes for a hilarious story and a date template is just something a teenager would try. While the first story is very funny, the second one is heartbreaking. Yuzu wants to buy Mei a gift and has taken a part-time job. She's working herself to exhaustion and to compound matters, there is a big exam coming up.

Matsuri is back, acting as a one woman Greek chorus warning Yuzu her intensity might get her hurt. Yuzu is also confronted by homophobic feelings among some old friends. That and school pressures lead to a breakdown and the usually reserved Mei shows great wisdom explaining to Yuzu how they will face up to the problems their relationship will bring.
