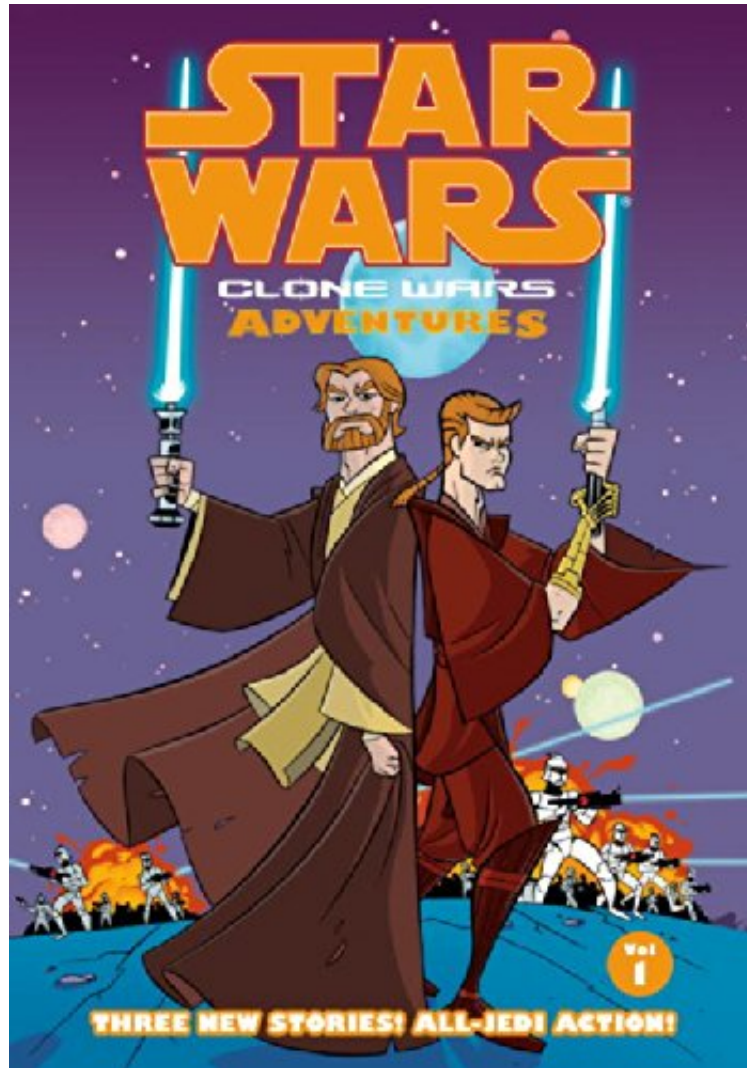

I don't have any complaint against the story, I rather enjoyed it. I just feel that for a product that is obviously aimed at kids, they should have made it so it would last beyond two readings. This book fell into pieces (meaning the pages just fell out, and not just some, but the majority) with normal use in the first week. My kids are avid readers and know how to respect books, so that wasn't to blame. I tried to keep the pieces together for a little while but just gave up and recycled the thing. The binding is better on \$.99 coloring books than on this.
