By Brad Barnes The CONVERGENCE event was a bridge between the unenthusiastic results of THE NEW 52 reboot and the best-selling embrace of the DC: REBIRTH titles! This

collection shows what co-publisher Dan DiDio intended for Convergence to accomplish which was 1) Bring back characters who had been removed from or simply abandoned by DC continuity 2) Bring back creators who had become disillusioned working for DC while it had been based in New York NY but now that DC was relocating to Burbank CA there was a chance for a fresh start creatively as well, and 3) Bring back DC's mojo. In effect, Convergence was an attempt to "clean house" in the DC multiverse by holding an Open House for long-absent characters and sorely-missed freelancers. At the time, Convergence appeared to be a poorly-executed Hail Mary, but in the wake of Rebirth, Convergence was a success beyond all reasonable expectations. The lead Superman story by Dan Jurgens and Lee Weeks brings both creators back to DC, and they are working on the Superman: Rebirth title currently. The Question by Greg Rucka made his current bi-weekly Wonder Woman: Rebirth title possible. Justice League written by Frank Tieri, who is currently co-writing Harley Quinn and her Gang of Harleys; also, his merciless version of Atlantis is reflected in the current Aquaman: Rebirth title. Batgirl by Alisa Kwitney resurrects Stephanie Brown, who is currently on Team Batman in Detective Comics: Rebirth. Birds of Prey by Gail Simone allowed for a pre-New 52 version of Barbara Gordon to reconcile with Dick Grayson, and Grayson is back in costume in Nightwing: Rebirth, while Gordon is back on her feet and romancing Nightwing both in Birds Of Prey: Rebirth and Batgirl: Rebirth. I am particularly fond of Rucka's "Just One More Thing..." which reunites him with artist Cully Hamner, because their versions of Renee Montoya, Huntress and Batwoman remain my favorites. The story beats he includes reflect the years he put into these characters, and the dialogue-free pages he allows Hamner are the culmination of their sublime collaboration making Montoya the Best Question Ever. As I told DiDio at The Grove a few years ago, Rucka delivers a gut-wrenching story, and I'm thrilled to see it collected here, certainly it's worth the price of admission. But knowing that Rucka is delivering the canonical version of Wonder Woman right now as a result of his having done The Question, back then, makes Convergence all the more special. If you are a comics fan, this absolutely belongs on your shelf. :D
