So reading Cosmic Callisto Caprica's story convinced me to start reading more detective narratives.I was particularly drawn to this one because it is written

by a woman of color and stars a young woman of color as an aspiring detective. Her name is Cosmic and she just graduated at the top of her class and will soon start her basic training to one day become a real-life detective. But before all that happens, she gets deeply entangled in the mystery of the missing/stolen Rings of Saturn when she is invited upon the luxury airship named the Titan. In the universe of this book, Martians are discriminated against and are often relegated to the lower rungs of society. So when the Rings of Saturn go missing and a Martian woman is suspected to have perpetrated the crime, Xenophobia goes into full effect. All Martian women are rounded up and interrogated, which is an outrage and Cosmic understands this to be an injustice. Her childhood Martian nanny, Wendy, falls victim to this discrimination and Cosmic will not stand for it because she understands that a group of people can't be so indiscriminately profiled. So she sets out to solve this mystery. The ensuing adventure is a fun, exciting, nerve-wracking adventure that shows Cosmic development as a detective and a compassionate human being.
