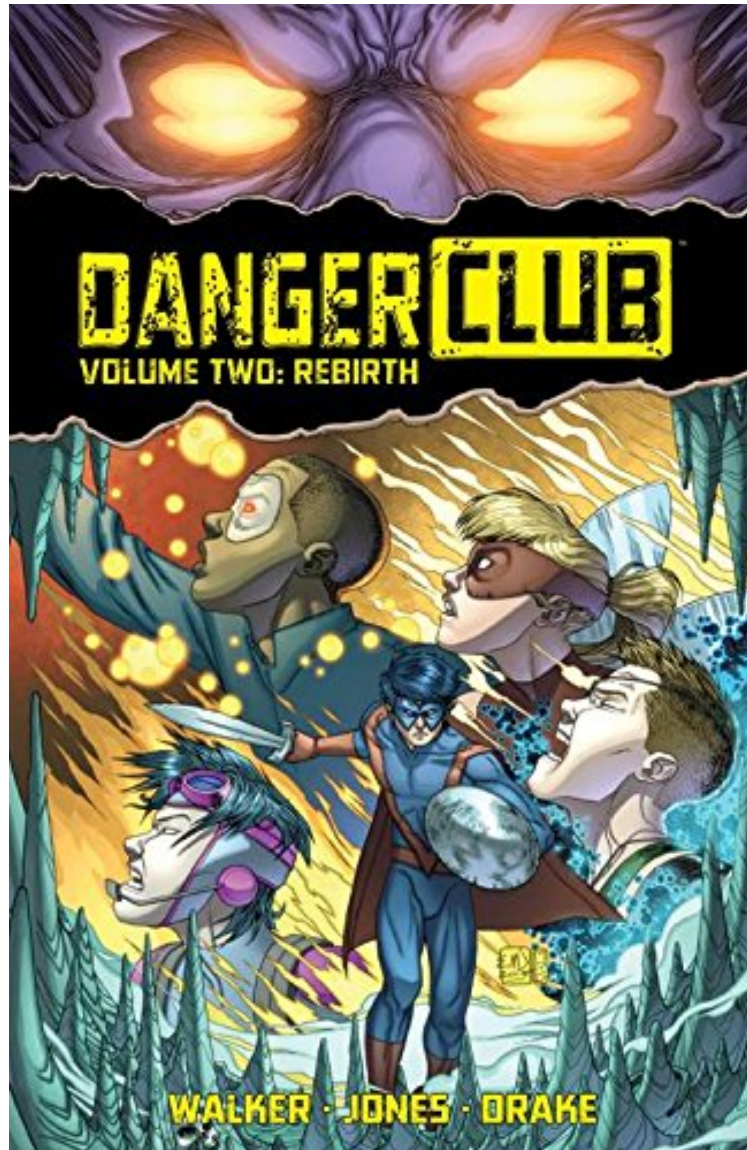

These comics aren't just "gimme" plot lines that have been done before. You don't get an extensive look at "this is who did this, why, where, when, how". You have to think a little bit. It leaves some things to the imagination.I love how the characters, good and

evil, resemble certain heroes we all know and love (The American Spirit hmmm.....). This is a dark and bloody comic, so be prepared to have your favorite character's faces bashed in (or limbs torn off, etc)! There's no, "I'm still pretty after being punched in the face by a 250 pound dude". The next part is a semi-spoiler, I'm saying exactly what happened, I'm just saying my impression on how the comic ended and where I think it's going from there. I'm not sure if there's going to be a third danger club, but they set it up so that it ended respectably where it left it. There's no real cliffhangers and they didn't drag anything out.
