But wait! They all move out to San Fran with Matt's new partner and girlfriend, Kristin. This deluxe hardcover is great at collecting Waid's very addicting run and giving Chris Samnee's art more page to gaze upon. Waid really puts Murdock through the ringer as he has to deal with an old foe from back home, dealing with San Fran's own blind street vigilante, "remembering" (Original Sin tie-in) something about his mother and father and investigating to get caught up in an international affair, and a very creepy Purple Man story. All of these stories are excellent and show Waid's master of pace, action, and characterization. And Samnee and colorist Javier Rodriguez bring excellent art to the table. The drawback to this volume is the 0.5 issues. They are just filler. They show off Matt's big heart and humanity but just are forgettable really. Plus there is a really strange flaw to Matt and Kristin's reasoning in dealing with Foggy and why the same protection was not considered for Kristin. Overall, a great read with a pretty good ending volume in the next. The first three are probably the best but the San Fran stretch still is some great story telling from Waid and Samnee.
