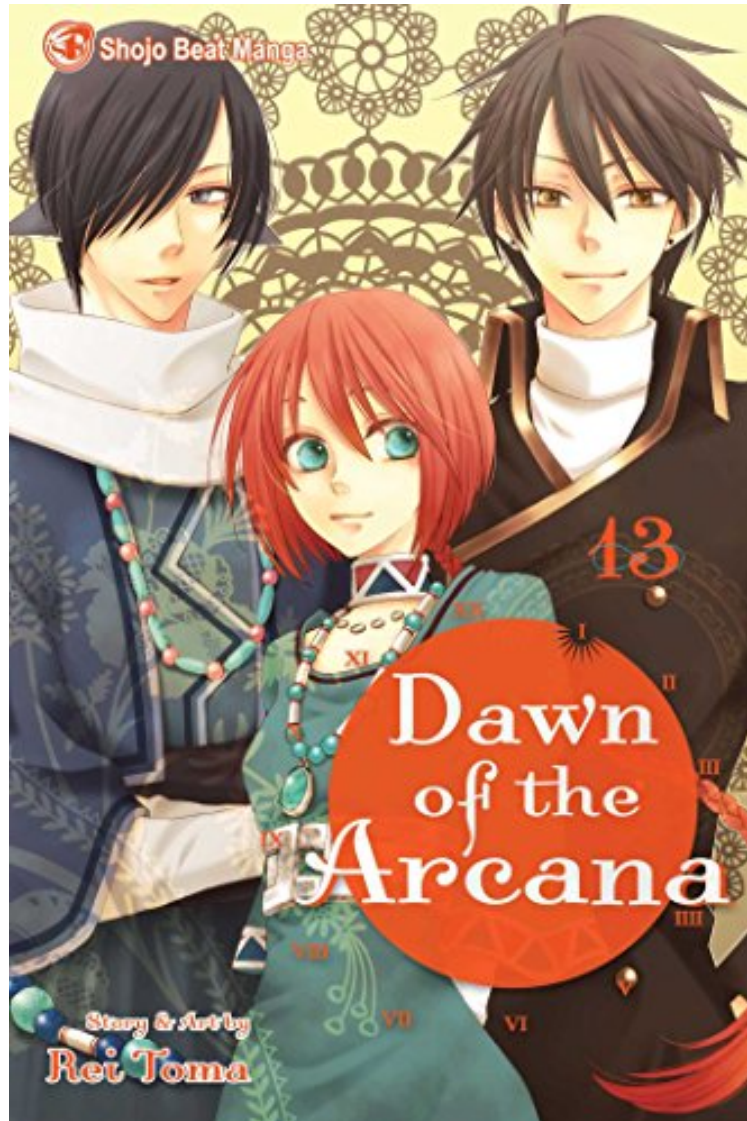

I wasn't enamored with it, and I thought it wasn't anything new. I assumed Loki was another love interest for Nakaba....but after reading this last

volume, it's clear that Loki was someone no one expected. I keep looking back at my manga to see if I read it right. The story is really amazing after reading this. Assured storytelling combined with Tomas trademark soft pathos combine to create a finale so perfect for this story. With several twists, don't expect a happy ever after but definitely know that so much of the foreshadowing in the first volume really make a lot of sense now in the final volume. Story: Loki has demanded that Nakaba give up Seinen to him. Caesar and Nakaba are left with a choice kill Loki or acquiesce to his plans to separate the Ajin from the humans completely. Nakaba's heart is broken and not even Caesar can heal what Loki has done. But the Arcana has one last gift for Nakaba a view into Loki's heart. I really enjoyed this series. Toma never took the easy route for the characters and situations she created making parts of the storyline very sad and several characters uniquely tragic. Although it would appear the series was about Nakaba or Nakaba/Caesar, in reality, it's clear at the end that the story was really about Loki and Nakaba. Especially, their past and history together. The ending chapters are mostly pictures that really showcase Tomas clean illustration style. She allows the images to tell the story, as Nakaba finally comes to understand both Loki's unswerving loyalty as well as his bitter betrayal. This ending comes at the right time; enough story to enjoy but not enough to where it drags out and becomes tedious to continue. Fans of the series will definitely want to make sure to pick up this final volume. With only her attendant Loki at her side, Nakaba must find a way to cope with her hostile surroundings, her fake marriage...and a mysterious power! Princess Nakaba of Senan and Prince Caesar of Belquat only married each other for the sake of peace between their two warring countries, but the two grow to care deeply for each other over time. Just when it looks like Nakaba and Caesar can finally unite Senan and Belquat, however, Nakaba's beloved attendant Loki asks that she hand Senan over to him! Will Nakaba give in to Loki's demands? And what life-changing secret will Nakaba's Arcana of Time power reveal during the height of her distress?

About the Author Rei Toma has been drawing since childhood, but she only began drawing manga because of her graduation project in design school. When she drew a short-story manga, *Help Me, Dentist*, for the first time, it attracted a publisher's attention and she made her debut right away. Her magnificent art style became popular, and after she debuted as a manga artist, she became known as an illustrator for novels and video game character designs. Her current manga series, *Dawn of the Arcana*, is her first long-running manga series, and it has been a hit in Japan, selling over a million copies.
