But this is more about "is there \$80-120 of value in these MCU Omnibus"? YES. I cannot come close to explaining how impressed I am at their durability, if not weight. I am a moron, but I took this 8lb Deadpool Omnibus on two round trip plane rides halfway across the earth... Iceland in the winter, and Maui in the summer. It saw every element, every extreme, and it held up INCREDIBLY well. Perfectly. Literally.. the spine and the book is in 100% condition.
