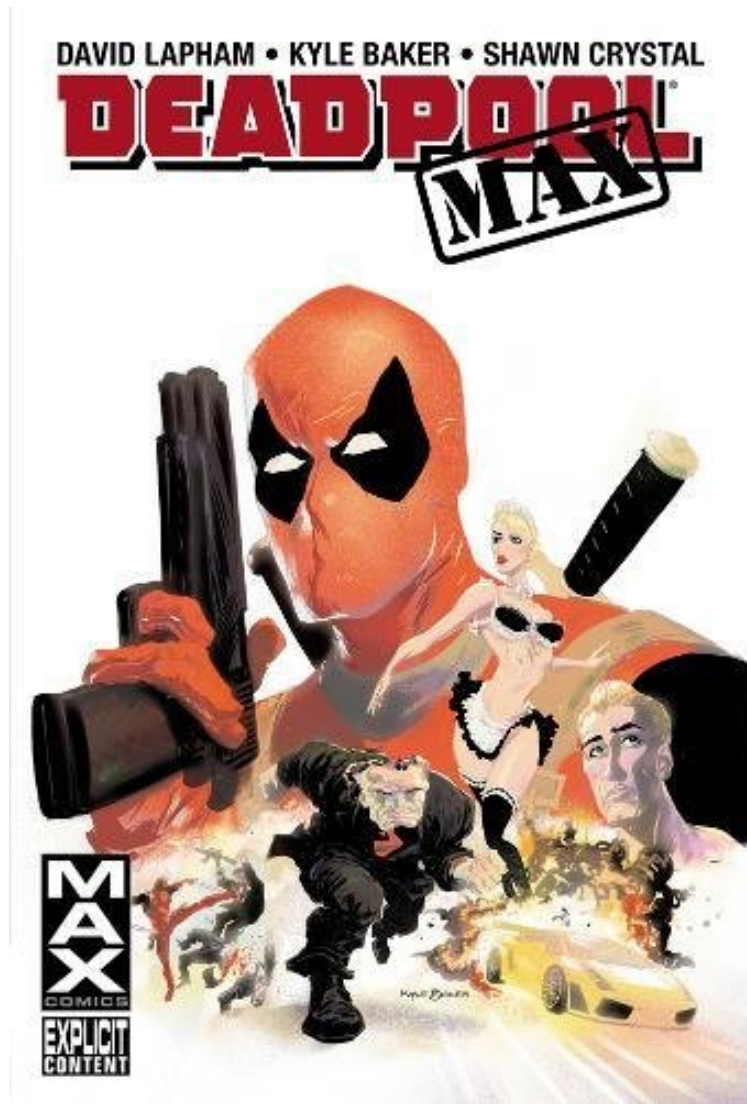

The logo MAX tells you this will be over the top and in some cases it really is. The most noticeable, cursing for the sake of cursing. I have a very foul mouth but when you read the things said in this book, you can see the amount of laziness taken on behalf of the writers to just insert lots of swear words into dialogue. I expected cursing but not so much that it actually makes interest in the

story all the more, less interesting. Then there's the violence and sex/"nudity". The violence is just summed up to limbs being hacked off. I can't really remember all that much more that really happened. Then there was the sex. Half of this book is just the female characters saying, "Are you going to f*** me or...?" or "...then I'm going to f*** you." The drawings were nothing but silhouetted bodies of one on top of the other and barely any real drawings of tits except for two particular characters, one old and one fat. So really, if you're looking for the MAX story twist the book screams at you, it really only delivers on the cursing; and it goes overboard.
