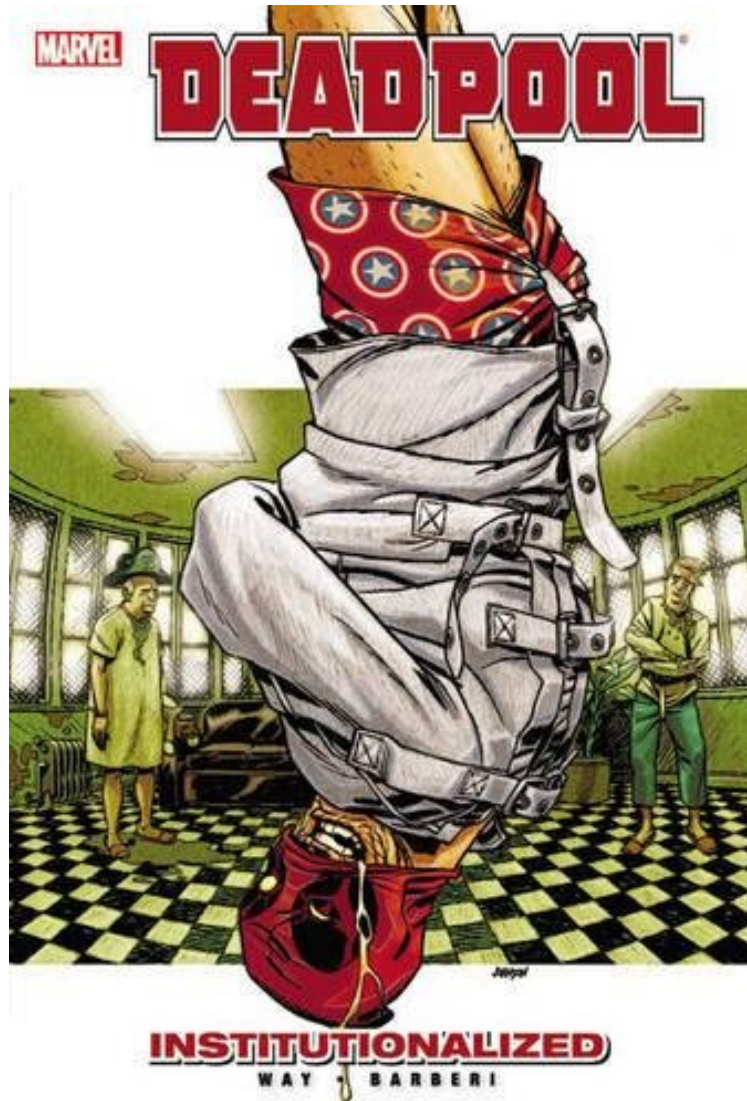

I never read any of the classic 90's stuff but with this pre-Marvel NOW run, I have kept up to date and enjoyed it. Out of all of the story arcs, this wasn't my favorite. The jokes were a little sparse and the

pacing for the story was a little slow. I also don't like a lot of deadpool without his mask...not because his face creeps me out but because, for as disfigured as he's SUPPOSED to be, I don't know if they ever do a good job capturing it...and I actually find him to be more expressive with his mask on. There are easily better collections (I'd highly recommend the Vol 2 Dark Reign story line or the cross over with the Thunderbolts, which is also Dark Reign) but it was still better than some of the slower standalone collections (embodied in the disappointment that was Vol 6). Overall, I kind of wish I could've given it 3.5 stars but rounding up works because it was still pretty solid Deadpool goodness, especially toward the end. If you're a fan of the character, you should enjoy it. Pros:-Still entertaining deadpool.-Interesting story line, even if it is a little slow Cons:-Pacing-Needed a few more jokes/fight scenes...-My personal preference of less face time/just put the mask back on
