During his time at Fitchburg State College, he became interested in fantasy after reading J. R. R. Tolkien'sThe Lord of the Rings, given to him as a Christmas gift. He developed an interest in fantasy and other literature, promptly changing his major from computer science to journalism. He earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Communications/Media from Fitchburg. He earned this degree in 1981 and later a Bachelor of Arts in English. Before taking up writing full-time, he worked as a bouncer, an experience to which he attributes his fierce and vividly described battle scenes.In the fall of 1997, his letters, manuscripts, and other professional papers were donated to the R.A.
