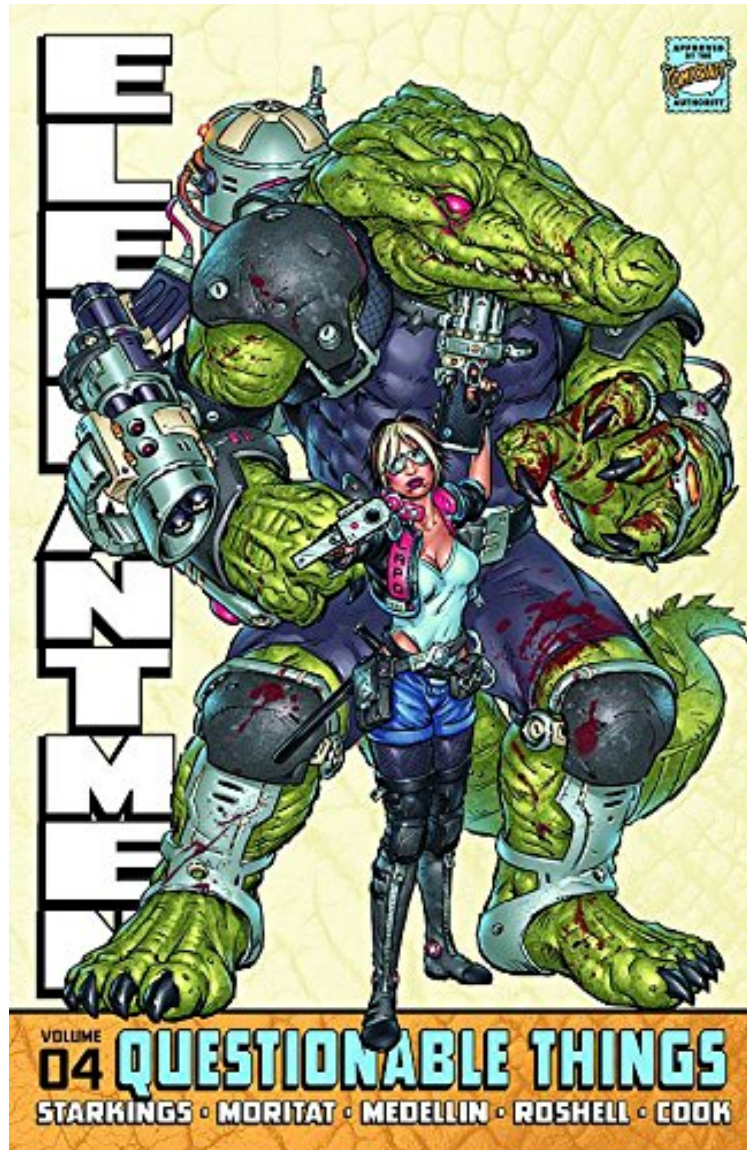

Richard Starkings is a master at weaving a variety of plots into and out of each other, and giving us a story of the future that involves complex concepts and characterizations. Don't buy the fourth book without reading the first three...but if already had done that, you would already have read the fourth, fifth and sixth volumes. The books themselves are huge volumes from a thickness perspective, partially because they are printed on very thick paper. It's probably twice the thickness of other conventional graphic novels.
