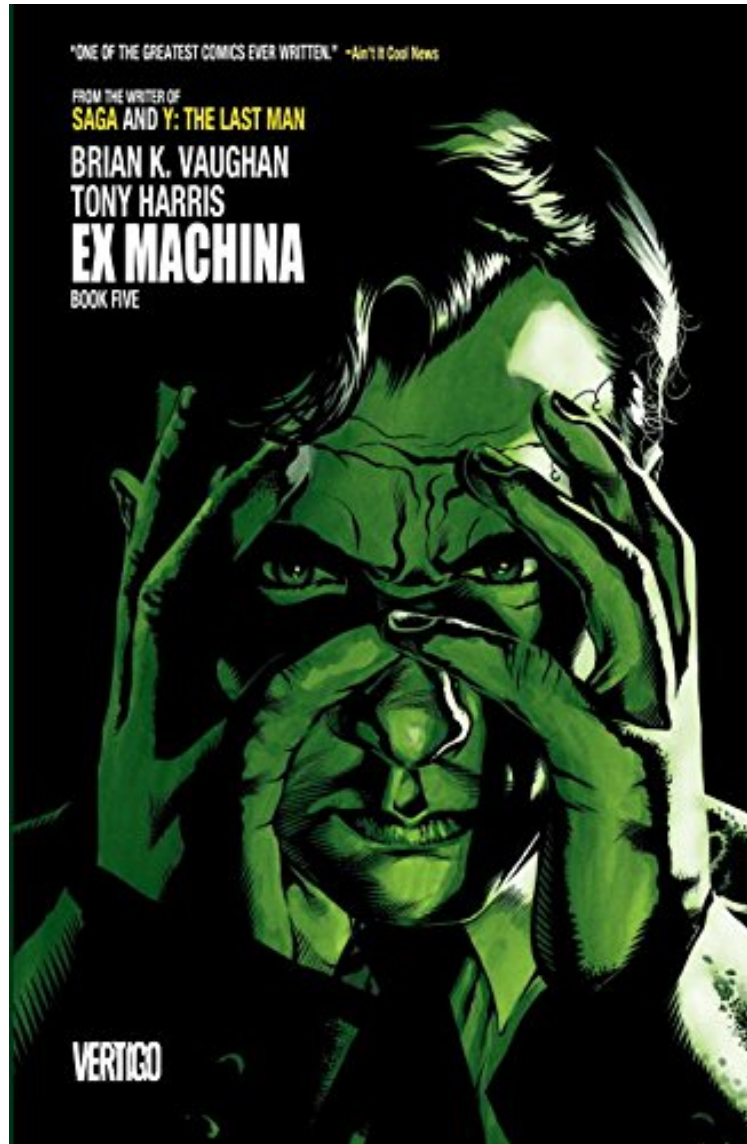

The plot does drive into a few narrative dead ends, but mostly stays coherent, and draws you in.
