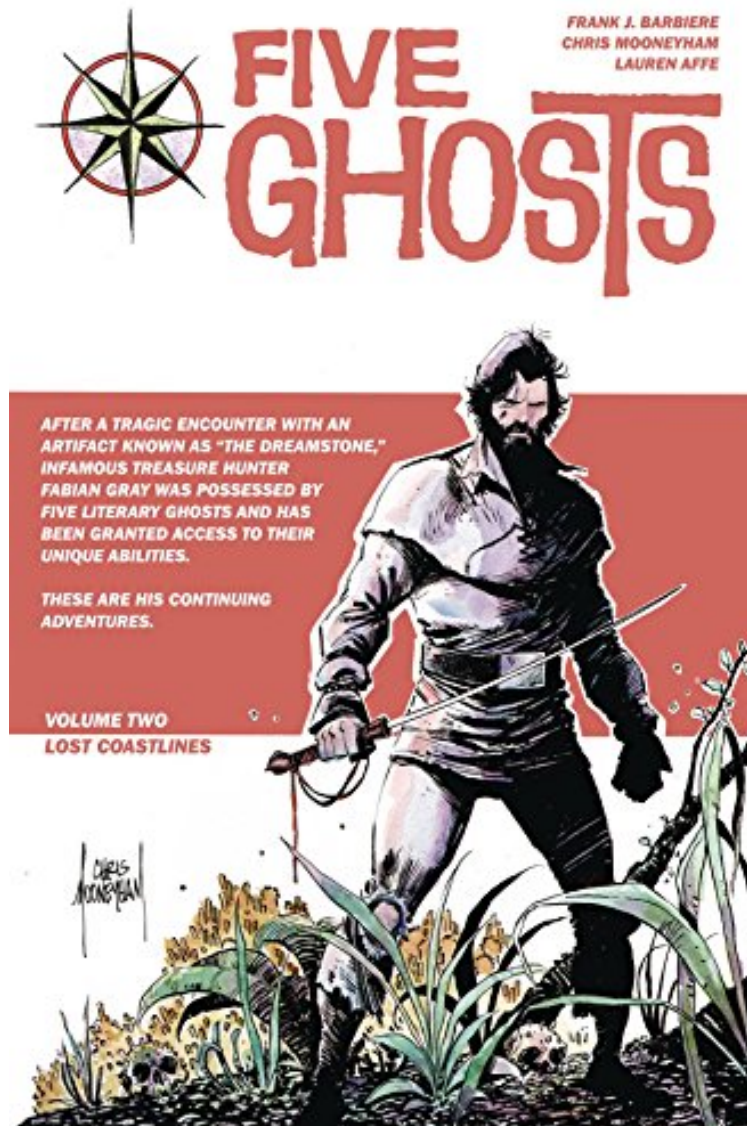

The story follows Fabian Gray, a treasure hunter/thief who, through a tragic turn of events, became possessed by five "literary" ghosts; an archer, a samurai, a detective, a wizard, and a vampire. The story is compelling and interesting, and while it

definitely is a pulp serial comic always ending on a cliff hanger and never actually reaching any point where the story might resolve, it still holds up as a great story, especially for the lovers of pulps out there like me. Mooneyham's artwork is spectacular and the coloring is way better than in the first volume. For anyone interested, if you haven't read the first volume, read that first. My only complaints are that they don't utilize some of the plot aspects to their fullest potential, like some of the "ghosts" in particular. For instance, the Detective is a pretty shallow aspect that they use in order to ascertain pretty basic things like a hole in a wall etc. I do have faith, however, that this will simply be a hurdle that they will overcome with more time and more issues.
