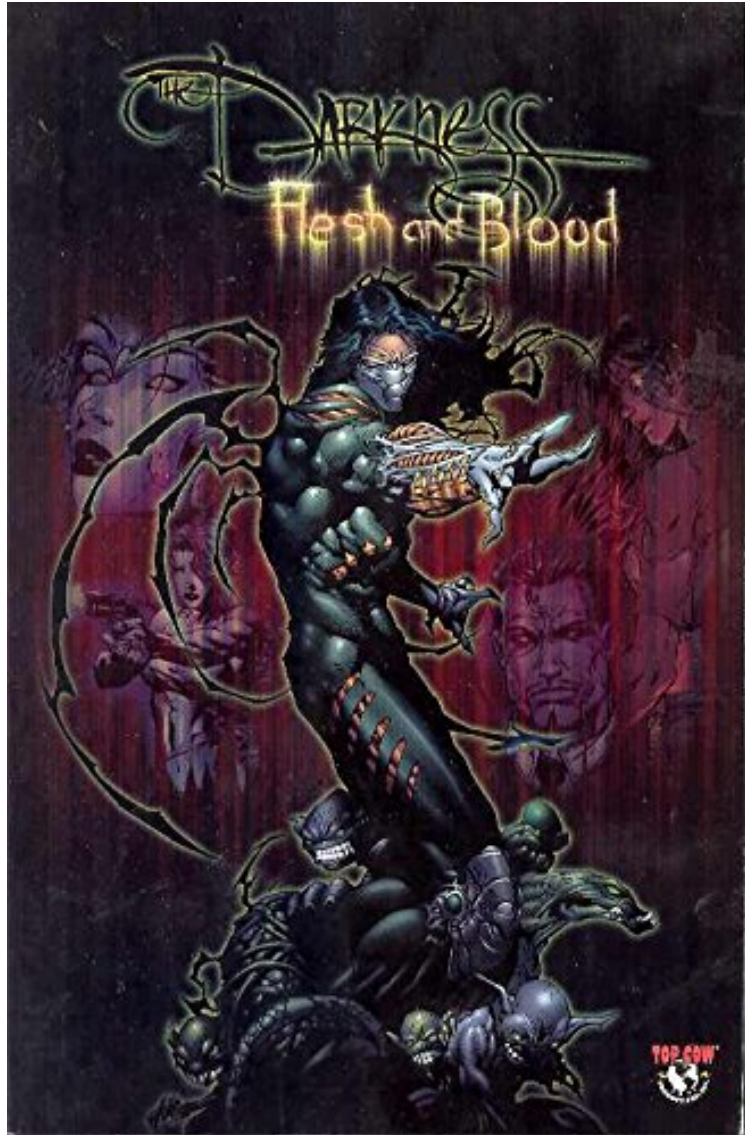

worst possible copy they could give me. The first thing I noticed is that the front cover was covered in scratches, nicks, and dents, and the corners were bent as well. These all proved to be relatively minor concerns, since as soon as I picked up the book I realized that the cover was not actually attached to the rest of the book. The glued binding was completely detached, and it was clear that it had been shipped this way. Why thought this constituted "New" is beyond me, this isn't even acceptable to be shipped as "Used".
