the way back to the first volume. Don't reading start here - go back to the beginning. Things continue to get increasingly dire as the darkest fear of the Kamisu 66 Acreage's Elders arrives and exploits their greatest weakness. Power dynamics change drastically, and Saki desperately struggles to find a way to save her town. With only a couple volumes left the overarching plot is solidifying, yet it looks like there are still plenty of harrowing twists to come. The tension and suspense are kept excruciatingly high and the atmosphere is incredible. We see the true levels of brilliance, conviction, and cruelty of their attackers and the consequences of the village's secrets. The diversity and depth of motivations, backgrounds, and agendas of the various characters continues to be one of the shining achievements of the series. The brutality of the story, both physically and emotionally, is as high as ever. The art continues to compliment this approach. As usual it's both excellent and graphic. The sex in this volume is even more tacked on and gratuitous than normal, and (likely intentionally) a little unsettling if you think about the situation, but it fits what has come before and is pretty much an expected part of the manga at this point. The intrigue and impact of the last couple of volumes is hard to match, but volume 5 does admirably with some more key reveals and developments as From the New World builds towards endgame.

There's a fox in the henhouse known as Kamisu 66-Acreage - a Fiend! Saki and her friends are now in a position where they cannot defend against their mass destruction. Those given their genetic composition and programming, even gods themselves run, but cannot hide.
