In the first story Macbeth, Lexington, and Hudson travel to London to protect an artifact of mythical and historical proportions. In the second story, Brooklyn is forced back in time 1,000 years to help protect a spellbook from the clutches of evil.I love this book. It's a fantastic continuation of Gargoyles and a rousing story that isn't afraid to shake things up. The real brilliance of Gargoyles is its

connections to mythology and history. You meet scads of new characters from the Illuminati, the London gargoyle clan, and Scottish history and lore. Every major character changes and develops, every story arc builds upon the past and links to the future, and every event feels intricately connected to the expanding storyline. The art is colorful and the action is exciting and well-drawn. The drama is unmatched for this genre. Even after everything changes, you feel like they're just getting started. I can't rate it highly enough. This trade paperback collects issues #7-12 of SLG Publishing's Gargoyles comic series. Issues #9-12 were never published and are only available in this book.
