For me, I personally loved Golden Time the anime. However in the manga format, Golden Time is not without its flaws. In terms of aesthetics, there were many moments in the manga where eyes were drawn in such detail in one scene but not so in others, and there wasn't a tonal shift that would imply that this change would make sense. And amazingly, Koko is even less likable in the manga than she is in the

anime due to her dialogue. Otherwise, I really enjoyed this manga. It was in good condition, and the binding was intact. This story is how I remembered it being, and I still enjoyed it.
