Furthermore, the Sinestro issues take place quite

separately from each other across the main story in Godhead so just reading this volume alone you would be quite lost. Godhead was a pretty enjoyable read overall so it may be worth renting or buying that crossover on its own. Otherwise you'll be very lost reading Sacrifice.
