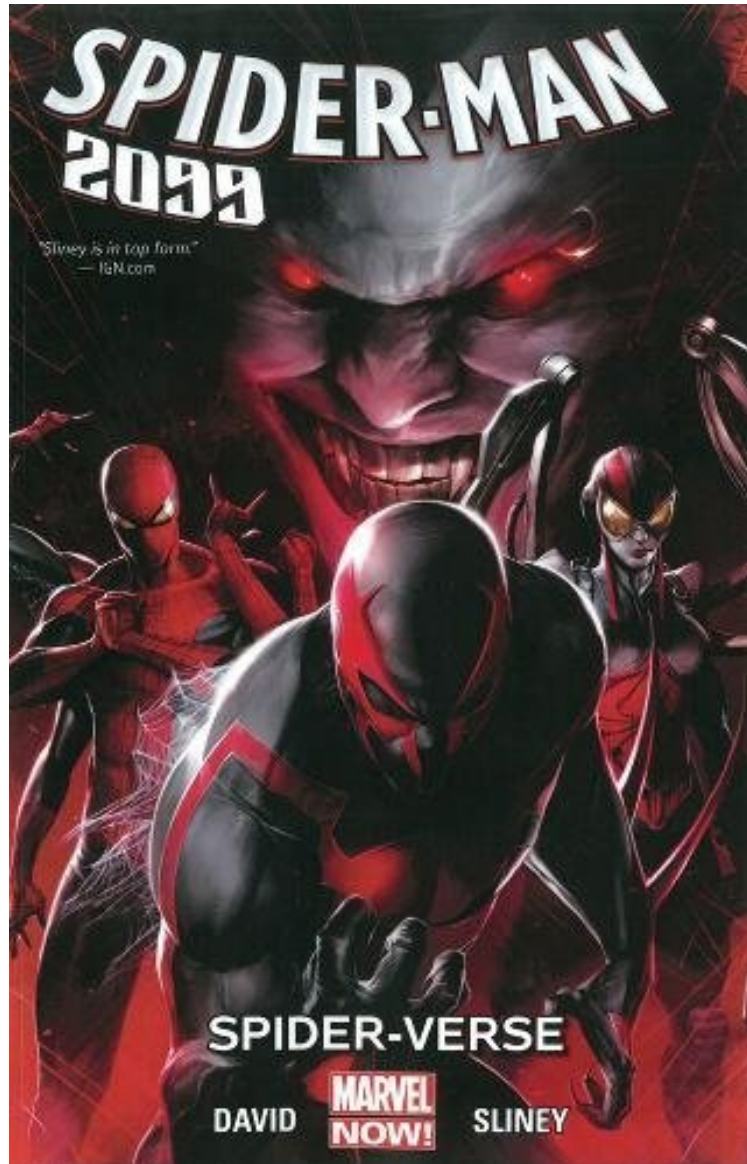

By Matt Anderson Collects Spider-Man 2099 (2014) issues #6-12 This was a really good read for me because it included two fun storylines. The first one was a tie-in to the Spider-Verse event. I read this whole event, so there was nothing lost on me, however if you are only picking up this book (without reading any of the main Spider-Verse story), I imagine that there will be some areas of confusion. Spider-Man 2099 has a separate adventure during Spider-Verse (though he is fighting for Spider-Man's cause), so these issues can be mildly understood alone. It will be jarring when the second storyline starts, though, because the time-traveling Spider-Man 2099 returns to his correct year in an issue of Amazing Spider-Man which is not included in this collection. When Miguel returns to 2099, he finds that the evil, future version of the Hulk, now called the Maestro, has taken over the world. I read Maestro's first appearance in Peter David's classic story Future Imperfect, and although I can't remember what year that story was taking place in, 2099 actually works pretty well for the story's setting. I wonder if Future Imperfect is an alternate version of 2099. Did Miguel's time travel have anything to do with Maestro's rise to power in the 616 timeline? (Because remember, Marvel has told us that 2099 shows the legitimate future of Earth-616, but Future Imperfect takes place in a parallel universe.) I love the Maestro as a villain, and I loved the Spider-Verse event, so this was a great read for me. I read some of these issues every month as they came out, so here are my ISSUE-BY-ISSUE, SPOILER-FILLED REVIEWS:

Spider-Man 2099 #6: Spider-Man 2099, Lady Spider, and the Six-Armed Spider-Man travel to the 2099 Universe to do bioscans on the dead corpse of a clone of Daemos. Time-wise, they come back to 2099 not long after Stone originally sent Miguel back to 2014. The Six-Armed Spider-Man dies in this issue, and Miguel's brother, Gabe, saves Lady Spider from a similar fate. They instantly have a romantic connection. Miguel uses some Alchemax tech to trap Daemos at the end of the issue. Spider-Man 2099 #7: The main point of this issue was supposed to be that Spider-Man 2099 and Lady Spider were going to dissect the dead body of Daemos to find out how to stop the Inheritors. The actual dissection part was minimal, and they found out that there is no way to stop them. So all and all, not very useful. Also, Punisher 2099 made a cameo in this issue. (2.5 stars)

Spider-Man 2099 #8: This was almost more of a Lady Spider story (with Spider-Man 2099 there for a team-up) because the story took place on her home world (Steampunk Earth 803). The two Spiders have to take on the Six Men of Sinistry (Green Goblin, Doctor Octopus, Mysterio, Electro, Vulture, and Kraven the Hunter). After they defeat this version of the Sinister Six, they fix the giant robot that the Spider-Man from the Japanese TV show used back in the Safe Zone. Then, the two Spiders and their robot travel to Loomworld for the final battle. This issue made the Steampunk world very intriguing. If it wasn't for the upcoming Secret Wars, I would expect that we would see more of this world in the future. (5 stars)

Spider-Man 2099 Issue #9: After the events of Spider-Verse, Miguel thinks he is returning to 2099. But everything is wrong. His world is a wasteland, and the Maestro is in control of everything. They talk a little, and Miguel finds out that Alchemax was the catalyst for this dystopia. The Maestro believes that Miguel is the Peter Parker Spider-Man, and Miguel doesn't correct him. Miguel is tossed into a jail cell next to a female I've never seen before, but Miguel recognizes her as Strange (as in Doctor Strange, I think). The thing I like most about this story is that it combines two Peter David characters (The Maestro and Spider-Man 2099), and allows David to have a fun adventure with these two creations. (5 stars)

Miguel O'Hara is finally back in his home era, the year 2099! But there's no time for nostalgia as Spider-Man 2099, Lady Spider, and the six-armed Spider-Man are on the run for their lives from the dangerously ravenous Inheritors! Spider-Man 2099 and Lady Spider, of the steampunk 1800s, bring past and future science to bear as they study Daemos, desperate for a clue to help battle Morlun and his family. But can they make it back to the rest of the spiders in time to turn the tide of the final battle? Who will survive the Spider-Verse? Will Miguel finally be able to return home for good?
