Brandon L. Volume 4, the last volume of the Big Time collection is a "big time" disappointment. There are only two actual Spiderman stories in here, Lizard: No Turning Back, and Danger Zone about The Hobgoblins. These two stories together aren't even half of this collection. 3/4 of this book is about this annoying character Alpha (created by Slott and Ramos). His story is generic "arrogant teenager becomes the most powerful superhero" and he really will get on your nerves. I would recommend buying, The Amazing Spiderman: Lizard No Turning Back, and getting issues #695 - #697 (Danger Zone), for those of us who just want to read the Spiderman stories before Superior Spiderman. I would only say buy this if you want to complete the Big Time collection for your shelf. 1 of 3 people found the following review helpful. If you are looking for a fun spider-man story I recommend the Big Time era for sure
