The Ben Reilly saga trades should be able to be collected into two very large omnibuses so that The Scarlet Spider's whole story would be collected into four very hefty omnibus volumes. When these issues first came out I stopped collecting comics about one month after the books collected in this omnibus were published. I enjoyed the story at the time in spite of the ongoing frustration of how it was being dragged out. It's very much comicbook melodrama on meth. Good or bad though, it's a famous milestone in the Spider-Man saga that won't soon be forgotten.
