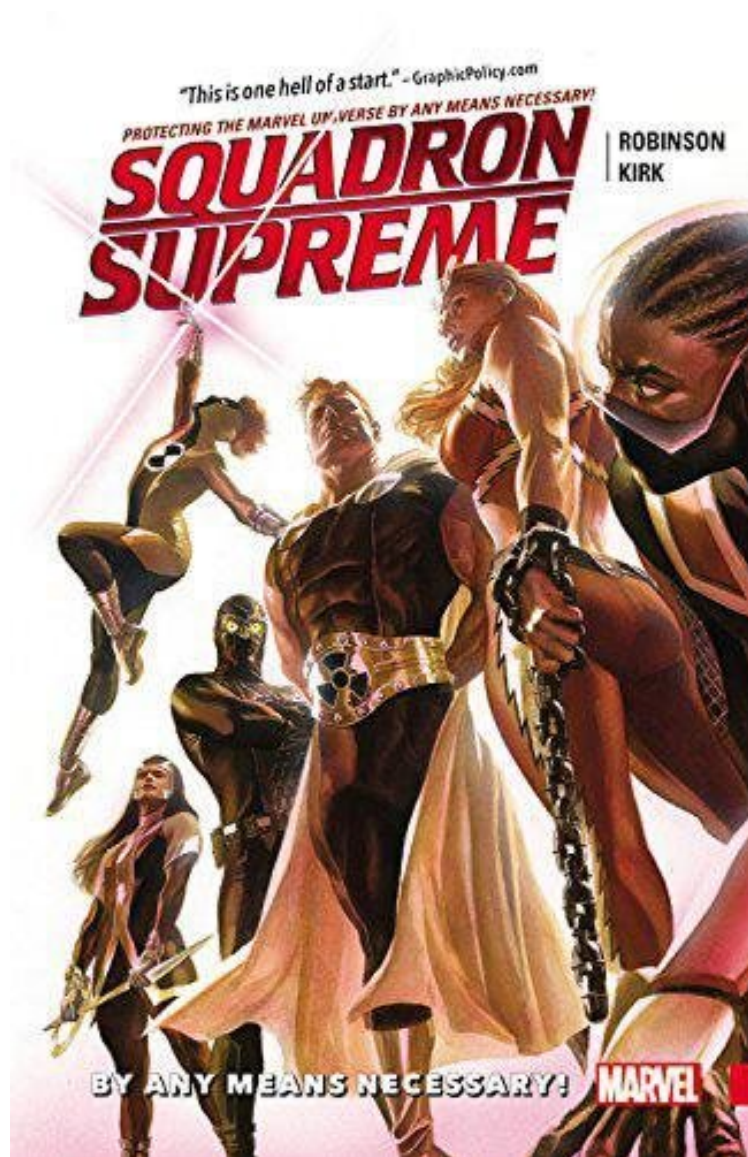

They aren't a team, they have no chemistry, most are angry and brutal. There's some seemingly unrelated Avengers content and a good chunk of the volume is a largely pointless excursion to Weirddworld Vol. 0 : Warzones! (Weirdworld (2015)).
