But this is one is all over the map. It

introduces several new factions and players (including a Hutt gangster who could give Jabba a run for his money) but never has enough time to properly flesh them out. We see them plot and scheme but it really has no impact since we're never given a chance to care about them. Kir Kanos is practically a supporting player in this story, since so much time is spent throwing in new aliens, new factions and new alliances. However, he uses the ruse to make his way to the Imperial leaders and assassinate those who wish to harm the Empire that he pledges allegiance to. However, he'll have to team up with the one woman who vowed to kill him in order to escape the hands of Grappa the Hutt and find the Imperial leaders! This second story to the Crimson Empire series shows a bit of Kir's bounty-hunter side and winds up a huge conspiracy plot against the Empire. The story was written well and the art was nice.
