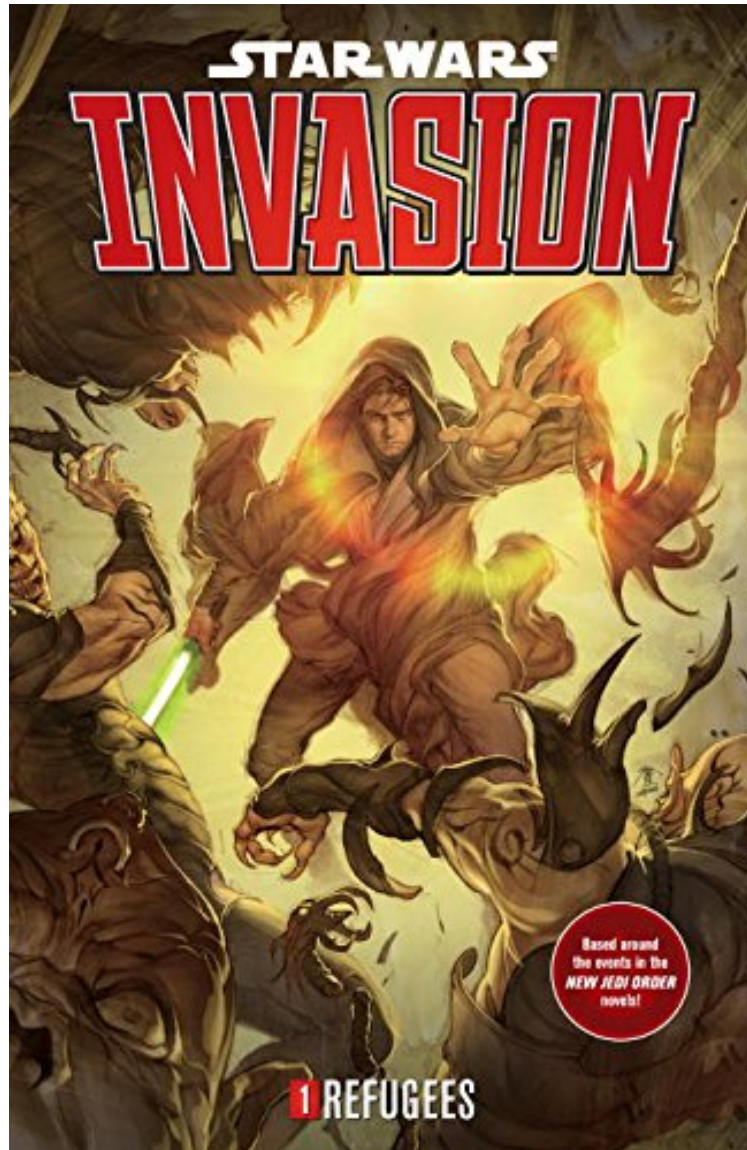

I've been scouring and my local bookstores looking for a series that was set in the New Jedi Order series and when I stumbled across this series I thought, Yuuzhan Vong and the New Jedi Order series. Well I just have to read this. The story is good, but not great. It has its strong points and its weak point so here are my pros and cons of this first book: Pros: The story is pretty good and while the plot is solid and filled with some surprising twists some of the surprises were a little force fed. You could tell they were coming before they actually happened. The Yuuzhan Vong. I loved the Yuuzhan Vong arc in Star Wars and they are some of my favorite characters. To see a book series dedicated to them is always great. It was nice to learn a little bit more about their culture and how they interact with one another. Some familiar faces. The appearance of Luke Skywalker, the Solo children, and the Solo parents is always nice. However I think they may have been overused and it would have been better if they only made brief appearances. Cons: The characters. We are introduced to four new characters in this story who frankly are wooden, overpowered, and in some cases downright annoying. The least annoying character would probably have to be Kaye. While she is overpowered she is still rife with faults that makes her the most relatable character. The same cannot be said for her brother Finn, who is frankly just an overpowered Mary Sue. His character came across as too valiant and self righteous to actually feel anything for. He progresses at astounding rates that seem to be forced. His relationship with most of the characters is forced and he comes off cocky instead of confident. The art: While some of the concept art is pretty cool, the actual graphic story art is messy. The anatomy is way off. The Yuuzhan Vong look like lumbering monsters I would find under my bed. The dialogue: Some of the dialogue is way too stilted and the writing can be confusing.
