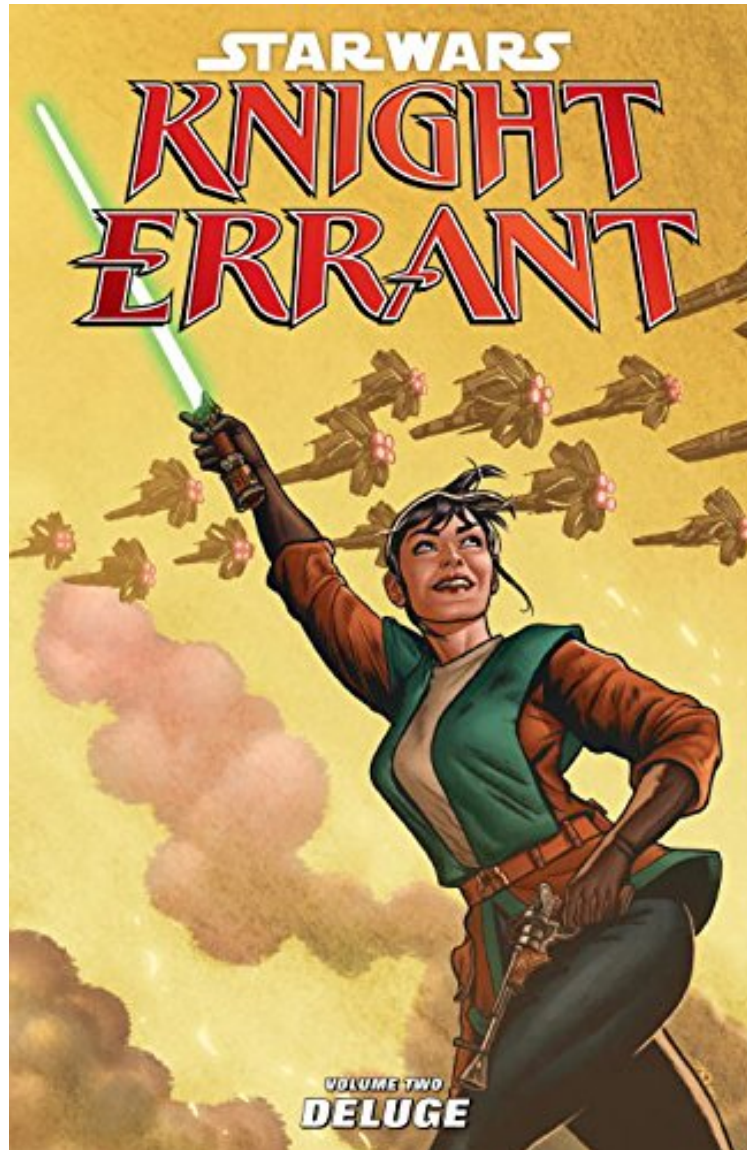

of Yavin. The Republic has abandoned huge sectors of space to the squabbling Sith Lords. While I did enjoy the story, I do not always feel that Kerra seems like a Jedi to me. She gets angry too much and reaches for her pistol more often than her light saber. The artwork is fairly good throughout the book. Frequently the story relies more on the artwork than the text to tell the tale. The characters could use a little more developing but that is the trade-off in using a graphic format. I believe there are novels that go along with the graphic novels which I am sure go more into character development. Aspiring Jedi Kerra Holt finds herself in the middle of yet another battle as a Hutt attempts to overthrow the Sith and restructure the planet of Aquilaris. Thankfully, a squadron of Republic starfighters are at the rescue and aid Kerra with the task at hand. Which is well needed since the citizens of Aquilaris are rendered near useless after being addicted to a drug known as Deluge. This story is decent, although I'm a little disappointed after reading all of Miller's previous plot lines. In the end, it was still worth reading. I give Deluge 3.4/5 stars.

Alone, deep behind enemy lines, Jedi Knight Kerra Holt has a new plan - liberate her homeworld from the Sith! But when her arrival on the planet coincides with an ambush from a Hutt mastermind, her daring rescue quickly starts looking like a suicide mission. That is, until a legion of Republic starfighters arrive, stopping the Hutt and the Sith dead in their tracks! With new allies comes a chance to go on the offensive.
