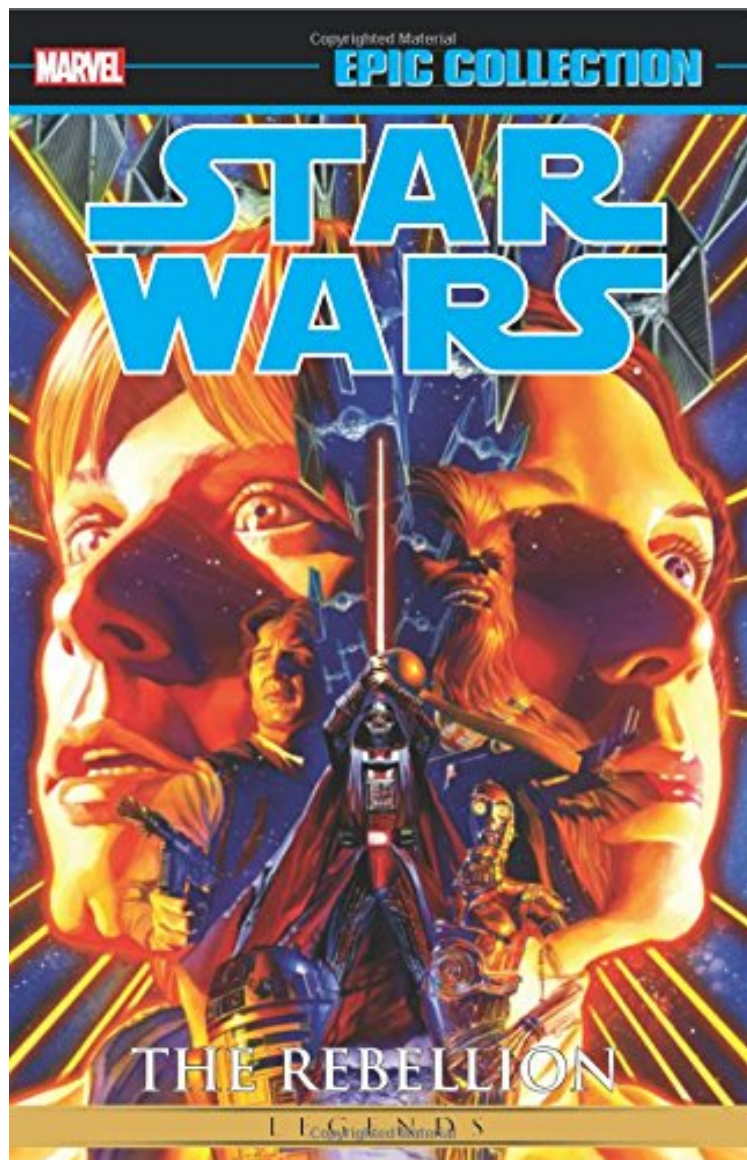

The stories at the beginning of the collection (from Star Wars: Empire and Star Wars: Vader's Quest) are the best ones, although Vader's Quest has been around in other collections (I have it in one of my others). I bought this to try out the 2013 series. It was okay going through it, but when you get to the last issue where you get the big reveal, it's just lame and unbelievable (even for sci-fi standards); you'd expect a better reason from Star Wars writers. Also, the Han and Chewie storyline interposed throughout is okay, if only because you get to ride along with them on a new visual adventure since the original movie, and the Del Rey books, which will always be cannon to me. However, the way it starts at the Coruscant bar, and the way they meet the trash lady is not well thought out; just sorta', kinda' "oh hey this person just happens to know how to deal with our issue." They just happen to meet her and she saves them from a few trouble spots because she knows how to do this and that... and she ends up having just what they wanted in the first place... I was actually enjoying it a little while I was going through the 2013 series, but the end was the let-down (with the Han and Chewie resolution also) and it brought the whole series down quite a few notches. Like I said, Vader's Quest and the Empire issues are pretty good, especially the single issue about Darth Vader and the hyenas, but the 2013 series is not good at all.
