I think it could have been longer.It was to see how the Keshiri (and the Sith) react to spacecraft and holograms.2000 years after the first LTOTS story, the Sith Tribe are still on Kesh where the people still see them as

gods (and few complain at slavery). "Death" Spinner is a Sith rebel who is tired of the treatment his family gets under the Grand Lord (and his family). The Grand Lord's daughter, Takara, is an officer who is determined to bring Spinner down. Spinner is exiled to the southern pole and Takara secretly follows. They come in contact with a civilization that calls themselves the Doomed - the ACTUALLY Protectors/Destructors the Keshiri speak of. Spinner causes some trouble, which allows Lord Dreypa (of 4,000 years ago) to escape from his oubliette.
