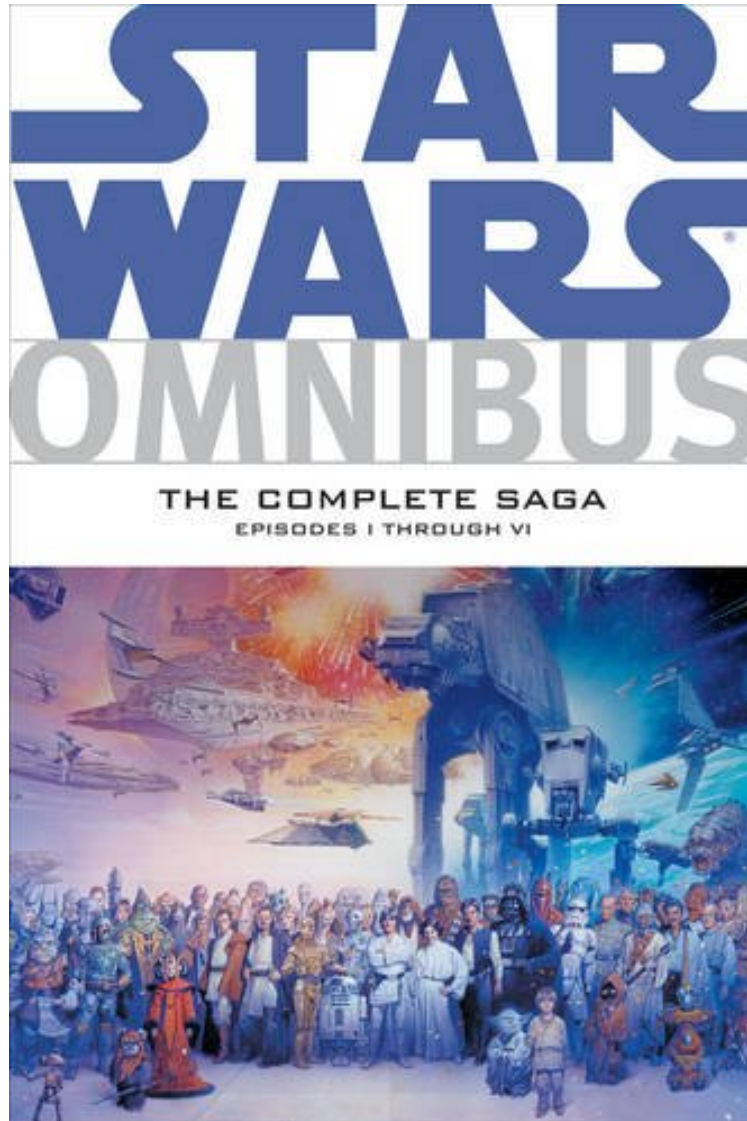

Even though, Star Wars Comics, primarily focus on the Star Wars Expanded Universe (EU), with all the prequel movies, Dark Horse has publised a comic book adaptation, during the

theatrical release of the films. In 1997, to coincide with the release of the Original Trilogy "Special Editions", Dark Horse released revamped (from the original late 70's early 80's Marvel adaptations) adaptations of their own. Back when Star Wars was in theatres (disregarding the current 3D releases) I was excited to get these comics, almost as much as I was to see Star Wars on the big screen. This Omnibus, captures the entire saga of the films in this very nice and convenient Omnibus. For huge EU comic fans, I think this volume serves as a good reminder to where the comics we all know and love so well came from, the 6 films. For a Star Wars fan, who has not ventured into the world of Star Wars comics, I think this is a good starting point to exploring the vast universe of Star Wars comics, and all that Dark Horse has to offer, and has offered in the past.
