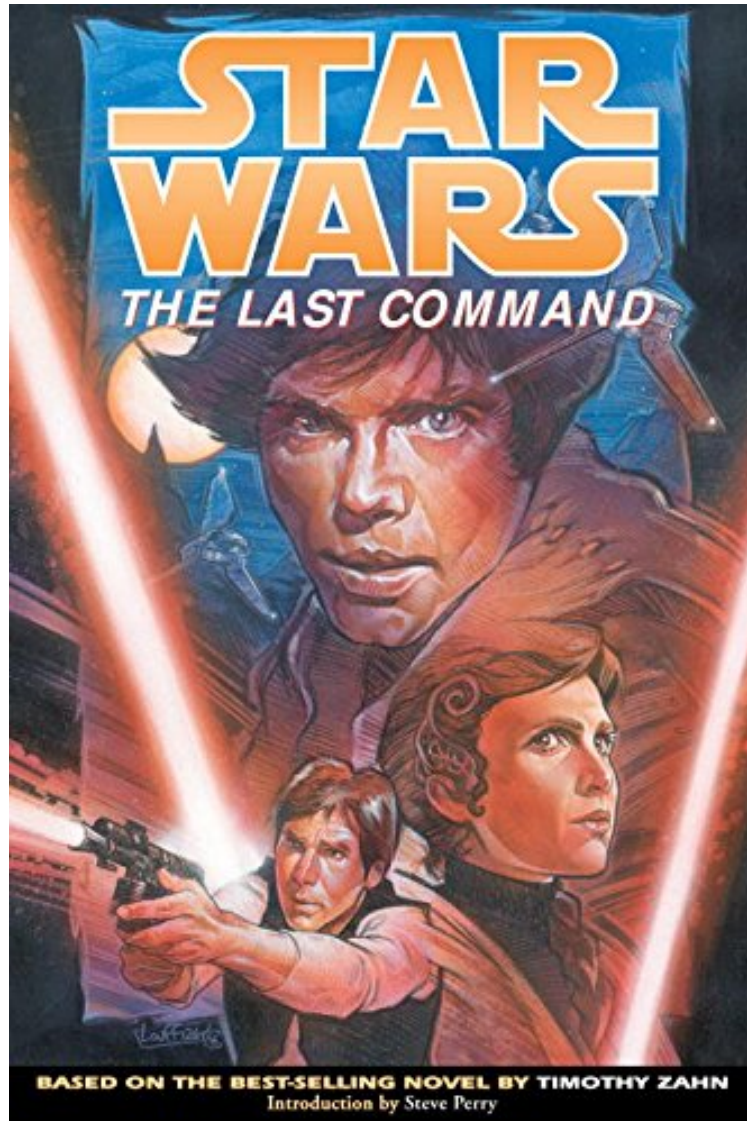

When I saw that the books had been converted into graphic novels, I was even more excited.This book is excellent, just like the other two prior to this one, and is the only Star Wars fan fiction that I believe really brings to life the original characters. If you haven't read the first two books of the Thrawn Legacy series though, make sure you do or you will be totally lost in this one.My only complaint against

the graphic novel versions is that it is very abridged. The original novels are at least 400 pages, and to shrink them down to 150 pages means a lot has been deleted. Also, least on my Kindle Fire, some of the pages couldn't fit into the viewing screen so not all the pictures could be seen. However, the text is still complete. I highly recommend this book to any Star Wars fans. Just be certain to read the first two books, either in text or graphic, before reading this one. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. There were some panels that were just indifferent (mostly featuring Leia or Winter, Leia's aide) and some panels that were stunning (mostly featuring Leia), and few partially-unclothed Mara Jade shots which seemed a little gratuitous. A lot of the big panels seemed to be worse than the smaller ones. The adaptation from the novel seemed okay, but I haven't read the actual novel in a long time, so that's harder to speak on.
