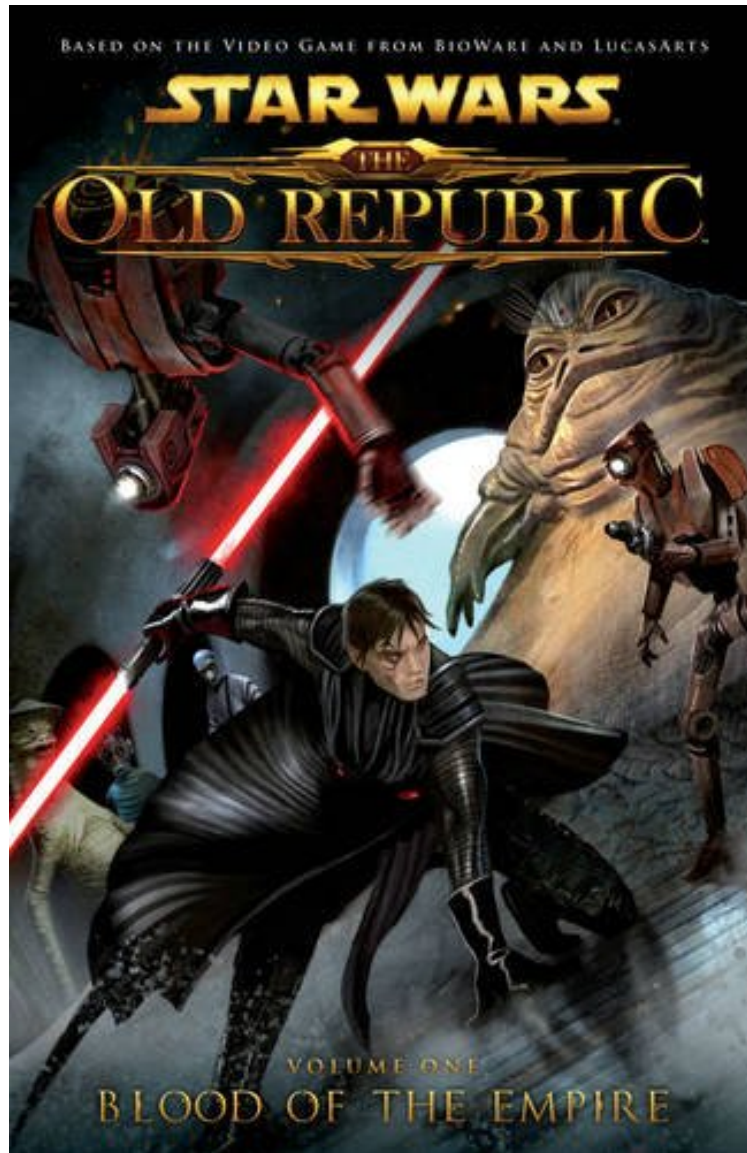

Teneb Kel is essentially a slave among the Sith. He shuns (then kills) his former master and takes a mission to prove himself to the Sith Council. He treats his non-human servant "Maggot" fairly well, though some others may not see it that way. His mission is to find Exal Kresh, the Emperor's former apprentice who no longer wants to hear or feel her master in her head. The Jedi are also looking for her and come into contact with Kel. A vision opens Teneb's awareness to what the Emperor wants and what he is capable of. Kresh thinks Kel takes advantage of it. But in the end, his heart is Sith.
