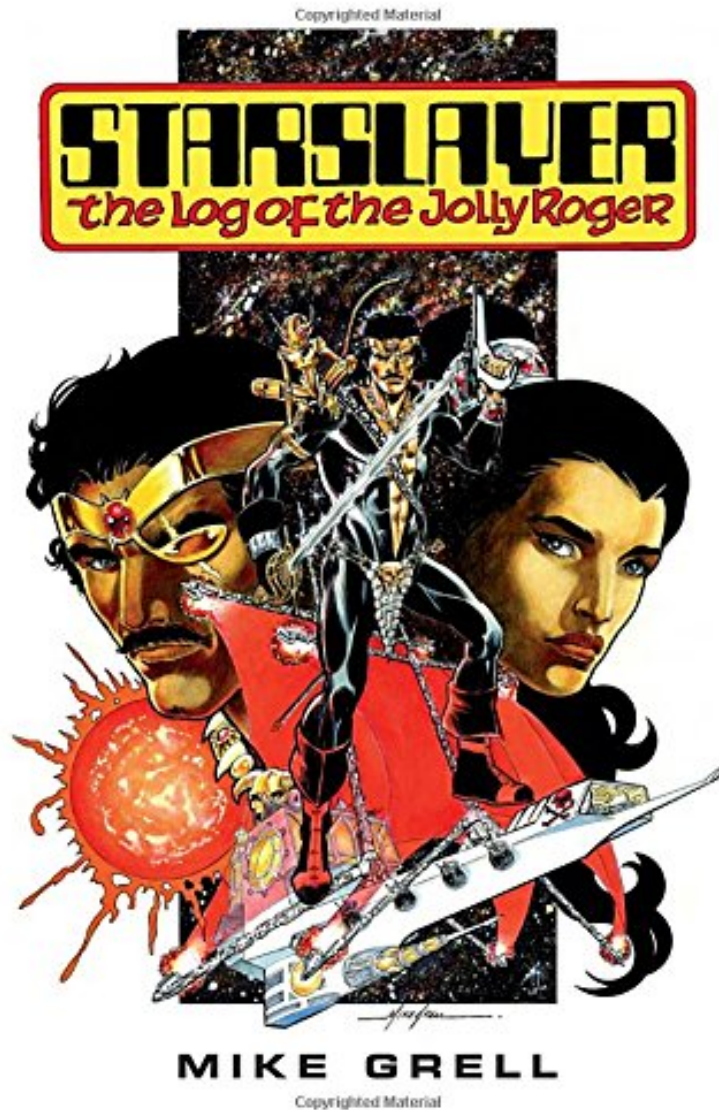

Only problem is, this is the worst reprinting I've seen in a long time. The book end first and last issues are OK, but the rest look like the pages were soaked in water then inked with a Sharpie. So muddy, ruins the art page after page. Did they just scan pages from printed copies of the original comics? It's worse on the smaller panels where details are completely lost. Almost an insult to Grell. The original fun and excitement still shine through, some, but this is a muddy mess.
