As is evident from the cover Cammy gets a lot of attention in the volume. We also revisit Ryus quest to improve in order to face has masters killer, Akuma. Following along is his young pupil, Sakura, Ryu seeks training from two of the most diametrically opposite characters in Street Fighter, Dhalsim and Gen. Ken is preparing to get married and Guile is dealing with an unhappy Julia who is tired of her husband constantly putting his life at risk.The first fight is an awesome one between Cammy and Chun-Li who recognizes Cammy as her fathers murderer. The fight ends in a no

contest but is great nonetheless. There is a rematch between Ken and Vega while Ryu faces off against the brutal Balrog. We also get round two of Ryu vs Sagat and a cool fight between Gen and Akuma. This is only an abbreviated list of all the fights in volume 2. If I had one issue with the fights its that almost none have a definite winner. Its almost like Capcom was loathe to job out any of their characters. It was nice that the artists care enough to have the fighters moves stay consistent with the video games. The minimum a book of this type needs to get by is the fighting but the SF comics go the extra mile and produce some decent characterization. Video game adaptations usually set the bar pretty low but it feels like Udon actually put in some effort here. Sure the story is based on an existing template from the game but its amazing how often game adaptions fail. There are some moments that are darker than one would generally expect from this kind of story. In one scene a character murders her own mother as a test of loyalty to M.Bison. There is even a shocking death of one of the games characters and we learn just what sort of bastard Gen was. Just as with volume 1 there are a number of artists and although they are not uniformly great there were no points in the book where I found the art bad. There are times when the art becomes radically different in style from the rest of the book but it never bothered me. I actually found it a little cool seeing the different artists working together to produce the book. In the end it all works together to produce a very attractive book. There are a lot of non-gaming licensed products with the Street Fighter name on them and a lot of them arent very good. This is one of the best. I consider it sort of a companion piece to Street Fighter the Animated Movie released in 1989. Whats cool is the Capcom, for the most part, stays consistent with the continuity between the games and comics. The comic does take some liberties but nothing that bothered me. The \$50 cover price may scare some people away although at this point it shouldnt be a challenge to find it for less than \$40. The fact is this is this is a high quality book which justifies the price. If youre a Street Fighter fan I dont think youll find the price excessive.
