Everything has led up to the big fighting tournament hosted by M.Bison and Shadowloo and all the classic Street Fighter characters are involved. Ryu is hoping to meet Akuma in battle, Fei Long wants to gain legitimacy as a real fighter and Chun Li wants to bring M.Bison to justice. M.Bisons motivation for holding the tournament is a little less clear but since its based on the events of Super Street Fighter II: The New Challengers there must be a tournament even if the reasons dont make sense (ok, he wants to add the top three fighters to his troops using mind control). There are also characters from Street Fighter Alpha including Sakura, Adon, Cody and Sodom but since Alpha technically comes chronologically before SF

II I guess it makes sense. The artwork is gorgeous and the writing is much better than one would normally expect from a video game licensed comic. When the tournament starts, things really heat up and I love that the comic includes an ever updated bracket of fights. Poor E. Honda got a bit of a buildup, with his desire to show the world the power of Sumo, only to get a beatdown in about a half second from Ryu in the first round. The fighters that make it into the bracketed tournament are the ones from SF II: The New Challengers so kudos to Udon for maintaining consistency with the games. My only issue is that several of the fights are purposefully thrown and one of the main fighters simply drops out after round 3. We also get a double knock out but I was cool with that since Udon didn't want to job out either of the two top tier fighters. There is a lot of Street Fighter licensed junk out there but this isn't one. In fact I would call this essential for Street Fighter fans. I won't deny that paying around \$120 for the 3 volumes or over \$150 if you pay retail is a hefty chunk of change that not everyone can afford. If, however, you have some money and you're looking for some SF entertainment outside of the games this may be the best there is. Street Fighter II the Animated Movie is a pretty good choice too. I really enjoyed this series and I look forward to picking up more of the Udon Street Fighter books including SF Unlimited coming in August 2016 which is apparently based on the SF III era. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
