Yeah that's pretty much it but trust me it has plenty of enjoyable skits here and there to fill in the gaps.The artwork is amazing and worth the price by itself. There are also some nice extras including a gallery of each original comic cover. The book is also very nicely made, it has somewhat of a foil like glisten instead of the plain paperback treatment that my Sakura one came in. Only gripe I have is I felt it should of had one more fight sequence at the end...you'll see what I mean.I hope they make more of these character specific stories, I'd definitely like to see a Cammy one detailing her Shadaloo doll period or Juri/Hakan since they are the newest Street Fighter characters with a limited character background.
