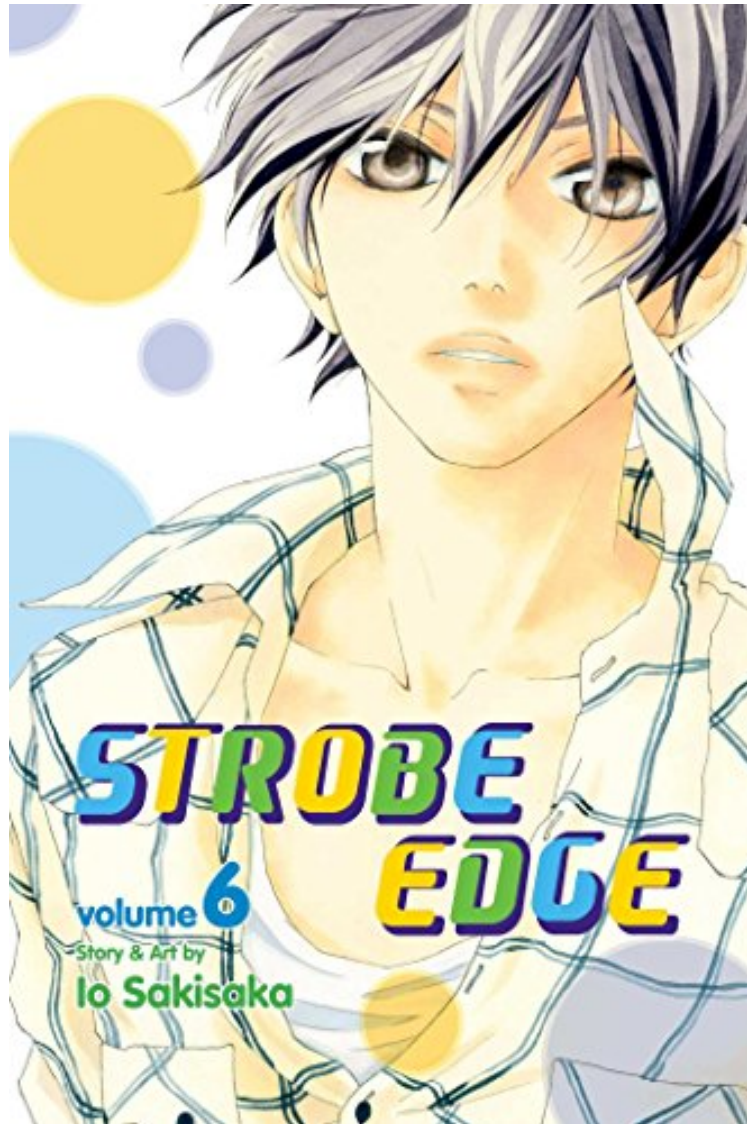

Okay, so, onto bigger things. News has gone around that Ren is now single, and all the girls are moving in on him. But hes still getting over the break up. And Ninako, the only one it seems, understands this and is just giving him time. Despite that, however, there are a couple of moments where they end up very close, looking into each others eyes and get embarrassed, and hear the others conversations with someone else. There are obvious things brewing between them, as everyone knew there would be. And Im kind of okay with that? I dont know what happened, but I kind of am starting to love Ren. I dont know, you guys. I just dont know. Maybe its because hes starting to try to find himself again? Hes been so lost in Mayuka, trying to stay with her, trying to identify with being with her, and now hes on his own again. I dont know, but Im really enjoying it. A big part is probably also that he had some guy moments with Ando, and they were just It was weird, but I was fangirling, and grinning, and I dont understand. Let me explain. So, you know, what with Ren trying to find himself again and all, hes realized that Ando is not really his friend anymore, and he doesnt know how to deal with that. Ando, apparently, came into Rens life at a time when he needed someone, and then something happened (a girl) and some more stuff happened (another girl this time Ninako), and Ando has been building up some hatred toward him. And so they talk a couple of times. Ninako intervenes, unknowingly, a couple of times, which gets them to actually clear the air. They still need to talk about some more stuff, I think, but at this point it seems like theyve formed a truce, and are kind of brotherly competing for Ninako, although most of the competing is on Andos side. Ren doesnt really have to do anything to win, and besides, hes not ready to try yet anyway. And really, their friendship at the moment is just hilarious. And while Ando is reluctant to admit how close they are, it has cheered Ren up a whole lot, and I like that. Like I said, I kind of love Ren now, and I dont know how that happened, but I think Im goin with it. I had a problem with how they both seemed to act and think that their lives would be nothing without the other, but aside from that it was really cute. And the art, while still pretty good, was very obviously not as good as her current style. That was neat to see. So Im loving this series again, and Im very happy about that. This volume was fantastic. And Ive come to realize that, even when things arent super exciting or anything, there are still a lot of small moments that are just genuinely funny (like the interactions between Ninako and Manabu those two are hilarious together; I love their friendship). I am very much looking forward to the next volume.
