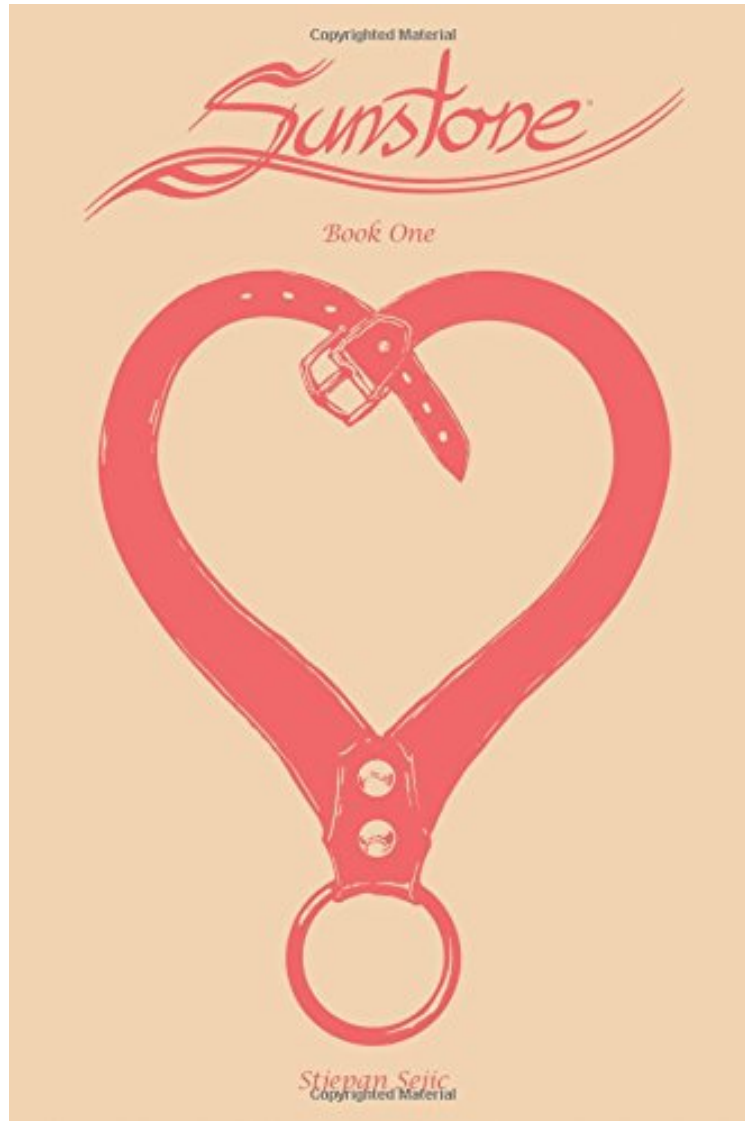

Sunstone affords a very practical view of BDSM, unlike some dangerously unrealistic novels and comics available, which could lead people to hurt themselves for lack of information. While this graphic novel does have some explicit sexual content, it centers around the human element of its characters, which are exquisitely well developed, and continue to develop as the story proceeds, causing the reader to emotionally invest in these people who do not really exist. This is the mark of a master story-teller, and I applaud Mr. Sejc for his masterful creation. I will definitely be buying the compilations, until Mr. Sejc discontinues the story, which will be a sad day indeed.
