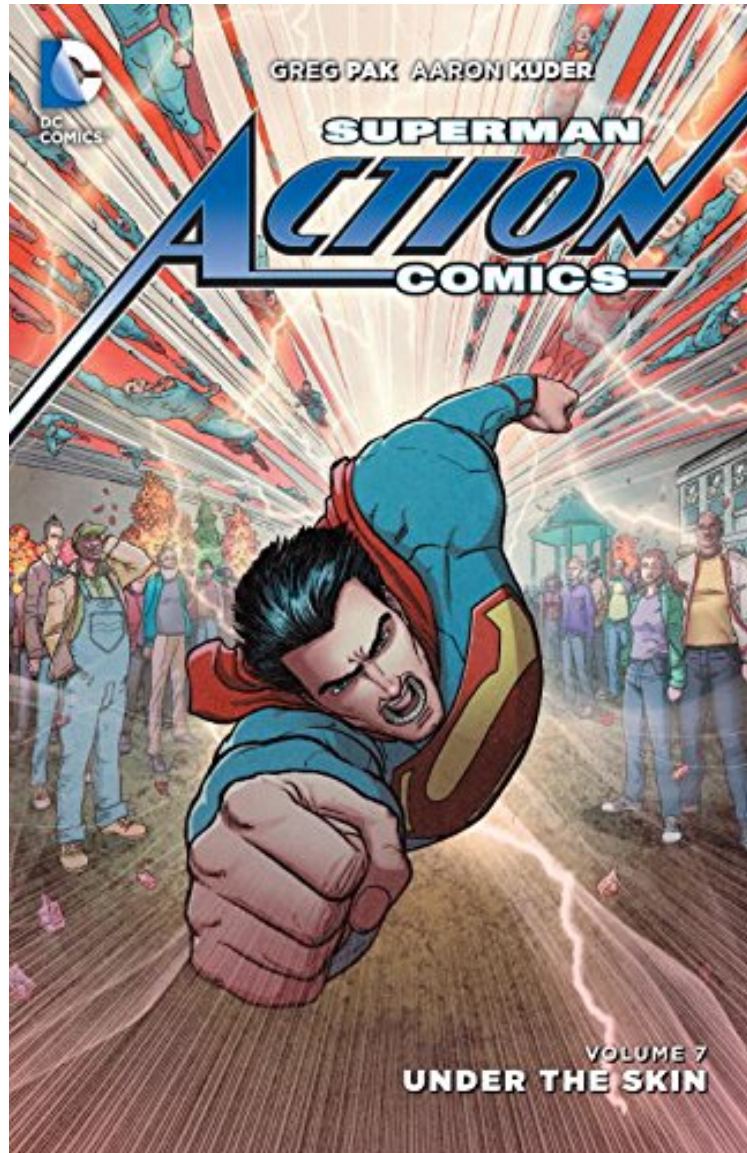

I was at a 4.5 but the outstanding and realistic artwork made my decision a five star. The current artist is fantastic and should be commended for his outstanding artwork. Another great aspect of this new generation of Superman stories is that Greg Pak continues the trail blazing of progressive ideals in the relationship of Irons and Lang, a mixed couple. With the death of Lana's parents, Superman must literally confront his deepest fears and make the ultimate sacrifice to save his best friend.
